Presentation of the 2015 budget

After the second reading was held, Councilman Dover motioned, seconded by Councilman Vance, to suspend the rules and waive the second reading. All voted aye.

Councilman Vance stated the Council has had possession of the budget for over a month and it was recommended for approval by the Finance Committee. He asked Chief Financial Officer Ben Barylske to explain why it's important for a city the size of Jonesboro to adopt a budget by the beginning of the new year. Mr. Barylske explained it is important to approve the budget in order to get everything ready for payroll purposes. He added the law does allow for cities to wait until January 31st to approve a budget, but that is usually during times of a new mayor, clerk or council in order to review what the prior administration approved.

After adoption of the ordinance, Councilman Johnson motioned, seconded by Councilman Dover to adopt the emergency clause. All voted aye.

Mayor Perrin thanked the department heads and the Finance Department for their work with the new budget. He noted if anyone has questions during the year they can contact him or Mr. Barylske so their questions can be answered.
