

BYLAWS OF JONESBORO BASEBALL BOOSTERS, INC. (Adopted 11/2003)

Article I Name and Object of Corporation

Section 1. Name. This corporation shall be known as the Jonesboro Baseball Boosters, Inc. Section 2. Object. The object of the association shall be to furnish for various members of the community the facilities, equipment and accoutrements for playing baseball in Jonesboro, Arkansas, and vicinity, and all business related thereto.

Article II Membership

Section 1. Incorporators. The membership of the association shall consist of those persons who have signed the Certification of Incorporation as Incorporators together with all persons who are hereafter received in or elected to membership as hereinafter

Section 2. Members. All persons who have, during each year, paid the required membership fee for membership in said association, shall become members and shall have the rights and responsibilities of membership as hereinafter provided. Section 3. Vote. Each membership shall have one vote only at a meeting of the members.

Article HI Government

Section 1. Board of Directors. The general management of the affairs of the association shall be vested in the Board of Directors, who shall be elected as provided in Section 1 of Article V of these Bylaws. The number of regularly elected directors shall be no more than 15 and no less than six.

Section 2. Officers. The officers of the association shall consist of a President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, elected, as provided in Section 1 of Article V of these Bylaws. Terms shall be for a period of two years.

Section 3. Qualifications. All officers, directors and commissioners shall be regular paid-up members of the corporation.

Article IV Meetings

Section 1. Annual meetings of members. The annual meeting of members of the association shall be held between October 15th and November 30th of each year. Notice of the time and place of the annual meeting shall be mailed to each member at least seven days previous thereto, or published in the Jonesboro Sun at least seven days previous thereto.

Section 2. Special meetings of members. Special meetings of members may be called by the President at any time on his own initiative or by the President or Secretary upon written request of five members to such officer. Notice of each meeting shall be mailed to each member at least seven days prior to the meeting or published two consecutive days in the Jonesboro Sun at least seven days prior thereto. At such special meetings there shall only be considered such business as is specified in the notice of the

Section 3. Quorum for meetings of members. At all meetings of the association, either regular or special, the members attending in good standing shall constitute a quorum. Section 4. Order of business. At all meetings of the association, the order of business shall be as follows:

(a) Reading of minutes of prior meeting for information and approval.

- (b) Reports of officers.
- (c) Reports of committees.
- (d) Election of directors.
- (e) Old or unfinished business.
- (f) New business.

Section 5. Meetings of the board. Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be called by the President on his own initiative whenever in his judgment it may be deemed necessary, or by the Secretary upon request of any two members of the Board of Directors. Three days' notice of meetings of the Board shall be provided by phone or mail to all directors, and shall be deemed sufficient notice of such meetings.

Section 6. Quorum for board meeting. A majority of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum.

Article V Election of Directors and Officers

Section 1. Election of directors. The officers and directors of the association may be elected at each annual meeting. Written notification of intent to run for a director or officer position, along with payment of the upcoming booster club dues, must be received by the current association Secretary at least seven days prior to the designated annual meeting date. Each active membership shall be entitled to one vote for each director to be elected, and the candidate receiving the majority of the votes cast shall be declared elected. The Board of Directors shall elect the league Commissioners annually.

Section 2. Terms. Directors shall serve for three years or until their successor shall take office, whichever shall last occur. Officers shall serve for two years or until their successor shall take office.

Section 3. Officers. The Board of Directors shall also include the President, Vice President, the Secretary and the Treasurer. To be eligible to run for President or Vice President of the association the candidate must have served as a director or officer of the association during the previous year. League Commissioners shall serve as ex officio members of the Board of Directors.

Article VI Vacancies in Office

Section 1. Vacancies. If a vacancy occurs among the officers or in the Board of Directors, the vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term by appointment of the Board of Directors.

Article VII Duties of Officers

Section 1. President. The President shall preside at all meetings of the association and of the Board of Directors and shall appoint such committees as he or the association shall consider expedient or necessary. He shall perform such duties as authorized by these Bylaws or directed by the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Vice President. The Vice President shall perform the duties of the President in his absence. He shall perform such other duties as the President or Board of Directors may assign to him.

Section 3. Secretary. The Secretary shall keep the minutes of all meetings of the Association and of the Board of Directors; shall, if requested, read such minutes at the close of each meeting for approval; and shall mail out all notices for meetings of the Association or the Board of Directors. He shall perform such other duties as may be required by these Bylaws, the President or the Board of Directors.

Section 4. Treasurer. The Treasurer shall have charge of all receipts and moneys of the Association, deposit them in the name of the association in a bank approved by the Board of Directors, and disburse finds as ordered or authorized by the Board of Directors. He shall keep regular accounts of his receipts and disbursements, submit his record when requested, and give an itemized statement at regular meetings of the Association. He shall sign checks and withdrawal slips in behalf of the Association upon any and all bank accounts. In absence of the Treasurer, any officer shall be authorized to perform those duties. He shall perform such other duties as the Bylaws, President or Board of Directors shall require.

Section5. League Commissioners. League Commissioners shall perform those duties written into their job descriptions as determined by the Board of Directors.

Section 6. Execution of instruments. The President and any other officer shall, on being so directed by the Board, sign all leases, contracts or other instruments.

Article VIII Duties and Powers of Board of Directors

Section 1. Management of Association. The Board of Directors shall have general charge and management of the affairs, funds, and property of the Association. The Board shall have full power, and it shall be the Board's duty, to carry out the purposes of the Association according to its Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws; to determine whether the conduct of any member is detrimental to the welfare of the Association; and to fix the penalty for such misconduct or any violation of the Bylaws or Rules. The Board of Directors shall approve selection of all coaches for the leagues.

Section 2. Rule Making. The Board of Directors may make rules for the conduct of the members and the use of the Association property, and define and limit the responsibilities and privileges of the members and their guests, not inconsistent, however, with anything set forth in these Bylaws.

Section 3. Appointment of Committees. The Board of Directors may appoint such committees as it deems necessary; it may vote for the expenditure of moneys as it deems necessary or advisable; and it may contract for the lease or purchase in the name of the Association of water rights, properties, or facilities for the use of the members.

Section 4. No authority to impose liability on members. The Board of Directors shall not impose any liability or levy any assessment upon the members, other than as required for league membership.

Section 5. Place of director's meetings. The meetings of the directors maybe held at such place as the President shall direct.

Article IX Compensation of Directors and Officers

Section 1. All officers, directors and committee members are to be non-compensated volunteers. However, the Board of Directors may, at its discretion, compensate members for duties performed. Pay rates will be determined by the Board of Directors. Pay rates for all employees, including commissioners, will also be set by the Board of Directors.

Article X Application Fees and Dues

Section 1. Application fee. All applications by persons or a family for membership shall be accompanied by a fee of \$15, which

Section 2. Annual Dues. The annual dues of members for each membership year, or for any part of the membership year, where a person or family becomes a member during the year, shall be \$15. This annual fee may be changed by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors. The membership year will begin October 1st and end on September 30th.

Section 3. Loss of privileges. Any member whose dues are unpaid shall not be entitled to vote or partake of any benefits of

Article XI Rules and Regulations for Members and Guests

Section 1. Definition of "family". As used in these Bylaws, Rules and Regulations, the term "family" shall include only persons, their spouses and children and stepchildren.

Section 2. Definition of "guest". Within the meaning of the foregoing, the term "guest" of a member shall include only persons actually visiting with a member at the ballpark located in Jonesboro, Arkansas.

Section 3. Expulsion. Any member whose conduct while using the facilities provided by or operated by the corporation shall, in the opinion of the Board of Directors of the Association, be considered detrimental to the welfare of the Association, may be notice to him of an opportunity to be heard.

Section 4. Additional rules and regulations. The Board of Directors may establish and enforce any and all additional rules and regulations deemed advisable and necessary.

Section 5. Upon whom binding. Each and every member of the Association, his family, and guests shall be bound by and abide by these Bylaws, Rules and Regulations.

Article XII Notices

All mailed notices to members shall be mailed to their addresses as given on the books of the Association, and such mailing shall constitute presumptive evidence of service thereof.

Article XIII Amendments

These Bylaws may be amended only by a majority vote of the members present at a regular or special meeting of the Association provided notice of the proposed amendment has been stated in the call for the meeting.
