THE HOME IS ON A BRICK AND BLOCK FOUNDATION THAT IS FALLING APART. THERE ARE PIERS THAT ARE NO LONGER TOUCHING THE BASE OF THE HOME. BRICKS ARE MISSING AND LOOSE IN PLACES. THE CUMBLING FOUNDATION IS APPARENT THROUGH THE HOME. THE WINDOWS AND DOORS ARE NO LONGER SQUARE. THE FRONT AND REAR PORCHES ARE FAILLING OFF THE HOME. THE ROOF IS SAGGING ON ALL SIDES AND PARTS ARE TARPPED. THE SOUTH SIDE HAS A LARGE HOLE. ALL SIDES APPEAR TO HAVE BROKEN RAFTERS. THE ENTIRE ROOF NEEDS REAPAIRED AND REPLACED. THE SOFFIT IS ROTTEN AND FALLING OFF THE HOME. WALLS ARE WAVED AND SIDING IS FALLING OFF. THE HOME IS A HAZARD TO THE HEALTH, WELFARE, AND SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC. THE HOME SHOULD BE RAZED IMMEDIATELY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF LOCAL CHILDREN AND OTHER CITIZENS, NOT TO MENTION THE BLIGHT TO THE COMMUNITY. PROPERTY WAS SECURED AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION.
