A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF JONESBORO TO CONTINUE THE CONTRACT WITH BRACKETT-KRENNERICH AND ASSOCIATES, P.A. FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF JONESBORO FIRE STATIONS.

Councilman Chris Moore asked if Brackett-Krennerich was the architect of the other fire stations. Fire Chief Leonard Jadrich answered yes. He added this is Phase 3 and in this phase the City will relocate Station 4 from Stadium to Harrisburg Road. He stated by relocating Station 4 the City will cover a service district that ISO required the City to cover.

Councilman Moore asked if Brackett-Krennerich gave the City a discount by reusing the plans from the other stations. Chief Jadrich answered yes, but they are charging the City the normal 7% with a deduction of 40% for the cost of construction. He added the City will pay 4.85% for the new fire station after the deduction.

Councilman Mikel Fears asked if this project needs to be put out to bid. Councilman

Gene Vance answered this project is for Professional Services which is not required to be bid out.
