After recent discussions with personnel of FEMA Region VI regarding the CTP process and flood plain issues, it has been determined that all LOMR's currently in process should be completed before the preliminary CTP maps are produced. This will allow the LOMR's to be included in the final mapping. They will need to be complete in advance of Carter and Burgess finalizing the preliminary map so they can have time to incorporate them. I am thinking we will need them complete by June 30, 2007. When I get a firm date I will let you know.

It is a MUST that you commit to a schedule that involves the Butler ditch LOMR being complete and resubmitted to FEMA by March 30, 2007. If you cannot meet this deadline please let me know by 10:00 am Thursday March 15, 2007. If have to submit a timeline to FEMA by Friday March 16, 2007. If you do not meet the time line, we have been encouraged to enact our penalty clause or face action by FEMA against the City of Jonesboro.

Also, we are in violation of FEMA regulation by not having this LOMR completed within six months of completing the work. This has been discussed with FEMA, and Linda Delamare stated we were not in compliance with her July 12, 2006 letter which required this LOMR submittal.

This LOMR MUST be in and completed by June 30, 2007 to be included into the CTP. If not the CTP will only include the remapping of our 2 foot contours and will not include the work completed on Butler's Ditch. This needs to be completed to fulfill a commitment the City of Jonesboro and the Jonesboro Chamber of Commerce made to Nestle.

My final request is that all correspondence to FEMA needs to go through the City of Jonesboro's Floodplain Administrator. I appreciate your quick response to the above items and look forward to hearing from you. If you have any questions feel free to call me at 870-243-5496.

In regards to your letter dated 3/12/2007 and emailed 3/13/2007, BA Engineering is only involved in the following FEMA LOMR Case Numbers:

Case # 06-06-BE69P Butlers Ditch Case # 07-06-0264P Whiteman's Creek Case # 07-06-0299P Turtle Creek

Whiteman's and Turtle Creek are currently in review with Michael Baker, Jr., Inc. with all requested information supplied to them. The updated digital topographic information was edited into the City LIDAR (2-foot contours) for Whiteman's and Turtle Creek and forwarded to Carter-Burgess (C-B) in the fall of 2006. The HEC-RAS files for Turtle Creek also were included with that submission.

As you are aware, the field survey information for Butler's Ditch was supplied to BA Engineering by the City of Jonesboro and was the resource of the hydraulic revisions to this model. BA Engineering has performed all FEMA required task based upon this pretense. FEMA requires certification of this information by the City. It is my understanding that the City could not perform this task.

The completion of this submittal will require certification and/or re-survey of the work previously supplied. I have had discussions with Mr. Ken Scrape of Associated Engineering to perform survey work in an expeditious manner. He can begin the survey work as early as tomorrow. However, neither BA Engineering nor Associated Engineering has a contract with the City of Jonesboro to provide this work. BA Engineering proceeded with the previous submittal at the request of City Staff and based on previous Chamber of Commerce and City commitments.

To meet your March 30, 2007 schedule, we will need a verbal commitment today for survey release and any changes to the hydraulic model should survey provide different results from information previously provided by the City and as submitted to FEMA. In our discussions with Michael Baker they will re-open our Case with the required review fee at the same review point. This will speed the review process.

The Butler's Ditch submittal is in lieu of the CTP submittal. Our submission has already remapped the 2-foot contours for Little Bay Ditch, Maple Slough, and Gum Slough. This was required as part of our submission as previously discussed with City Staff.
