Policy discussion concerning alderman resignations

Chairman McCall read the following policy concerning filling a alderman vacancy:

If a vacancy occurs in an alderman position, the City Council is authorized to fill that vacancy. If there are two years or less left in the term of the position which is vacant, the position shall be filled by a vote of the sitting alderman. If, however, there are more than two years left in the term of the position which is vacant, the position shall be filled by a special called election and a vote of the citizens. If there is a reason that would make it impractical to hold a special election, a two thirds vote of the sitting alderman can determine that the position be filled by a vote of the alderman, no

matter the length left in the vacant term.

Councilman Dover motioned, seconded by Councilman Johnson, that this be written as a resolution by the City Attorney and then brought back to the Nominating & Rules Committee. All voted aye.
