Resolutions To Be Introduced

RES-07:186 A RESOLUTION TO LOCATE CITY PARKS AND OTHER GREENSPACE ADJACENT TO POLICE AND FIRE STATIONS WHERE FEASIBLE

Sponsors: Parks & Recreation

Parks Director Jason Wilkie explained the Land Use Committee forwarded the resolution to him for consideration. He further explained the resolution would recommend developing parks with fire and police stations, but it would not be mandatory. He noted he sent the resolution to the Fire and Police Chiefs and they were okay with it. Discussion was also held concerning whether the City can require developers to provide greenspace so a park can be built. Councilman Province stated it was his understanding the City could not legally require developers to do that. Discussion was also held concerning putting parks in where the City is developing detention ponds. Mr. Wilkie explained they could build baseball fields or walking perimeters depending on the size of the pond.

A motion was made by Councilperson Jim Hargis, seconded by Councilperson Cecil Province, that this matter be Recommended to the Public Works Council Committee. The motion PASSED by an unanimous vote

Councilman Frierson motioned, seconded by Councilman Hargis, to not recommend re-naming the parks because it does not meet the requirements as set in the resolution. All voted aye.
