Expansion - Reasons

The management from Jonesboro Concrete Pipe Co., Inc. has, for the past two years, been developing long range objectives in order to position ourselves for future growth. We have made trips to Europe, Canada, and many locations in the United States to view existing facilities and learn the latest technology in the production and marketing of concrete products.

Jonesboro Concrete Pipe, at present, has in operation two concrete pipe machines both using the packerhead process. This process uses no slump concrete which will produce high strength concrete and allow for high production rates. The problem with this type of process is that it will only produce round pipe. All of our non-round concrete products must be manufactured by the "wet-cast" process.

The market trends are toward more and more precast items such as boxes, inlets, elliptical, and other non round items. The reason for this shift is to reduce labor costs out on the job, as well reduce the time it takes to do a job. We feel the trend will only increase.

Using a dry-cast method (lower water content) for most all of our structures as well as concrete pipe through vibration will increase our quality as well as reduce our production time. We also intend to install a computerized batching system which will give us a precise mix design. This modernization would allow JCP to:

- 1. Produce a higher quality product through automation.
- 2. The ability to produce a denser product more suitable to sanitary sewers which should open up new markets.
- 3. A new plant lay out will allow us to integrate the most current OSHA and EPA regulations as well as safety procedures in an easily workable environment.

The surroundings areas, are requiring more and more concrete products which we now produce as non-standard or "wet-cast'





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items. Simply stated, this means we cannot produce these items on a machine. Although this is an acceptable and workable method, its drawbacks are (1) it is slow and (2) it is labor intensive and (3) it takes a disproportionately large production area. The most critical of these points is a slow production rate. If we delay production until the job is awarded our slow production rate may not enable us to do the work. We feel rapid production rates will increase the demand for our products as well as open new markets.

We produce products that transport sewage away from cities, storm water away from roads, as well as other products, all of which are necessary for the infrastructure development.

This expansion will not only add a minimum of 2 full time positions to our company but the community will gain revenue from the large purchases of equipment from two manufacturers and the building contractor located in Jonesboro, AR.

Our rough estimates are the building will run approximately 600,000. Equipment, tools and moving cost will add another 850,000 bringing the total to nearly 1.5 million dollars. With a large portion going to local businesses.
