HOME WAS INVOLVED IN A FIRE ON 8/23/2022. ACCORDING TO THE JONESBORO FIRE DEPARTMENT THE FIRE STARTED IN THE FRONT ROOM TO THE LEFT OF THE FRONT DOOR. THE ROOF AND RAFTERS WERE SEVERLY DAMAGED AND WOULD HAVE TO BE COMPLETELY REPLACED. THE DOORS AND WINDOWS ARE BROKEN, MISSING, OR DAMAGED BY FIRE AND WATER. THE INTERIOR WALLS ARE DAMAGED BY FIRE AND WATER. THE FLOOR IS DAMAGED BY FIRE AND WATER. THE SOFFIT AREA IS ROTTEN, FIRE, AND SMOKE DAMAGED. THE ENTIRE HOME HAS SMOKE AND WATER DAMAGE. A MAJORITY OF THE HOME IS FULL OF JUNK MAKING IT HARD TO COMPLETELY ASSESS THE DAMAGE BUT FROM WHAT IS VISIABLE THE HOME IS A HAZARD TO THE HEALTH, WELFARE, AND SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC. THE HOME SHOULD BE RAZED IMMEDIATELY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF LOCAL CHILDREN AND OTHER CITIZENS, NOT TO MENTION THE BLIGHT TO THE COMMUNITY.
