The 2017 Program Year will run July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. Proposals for CDBG Public Service program must directly benefit LMI area or individuals as determined by HUD Income Limits. The City of Jonesboro is planning to award 3 to 6 proposals for the FY 2017 planning year. Total amount of funding available is \$60,000 for all public service awards.
