

AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Nettleton School Board is petitioning the City Council to close the following streets in the Harley - Kiech Addition to the City of Nettleton, Arkansas, to-wit:

All of Lombardy Drive;
All of Dahlia Lane;
All of Gladiola Drive;
All of Rose Lane;
All of Paradise Drive, except that part of Paradise Drive running northwesterly from the eastern intersection line of Progress Drive with Paradise Drive (so that the only streets in the Harley-Kiech Addition will be Progress Drive and Paradise Drive running from Elm Road to Progress Drive).

WHEREAS, the streets being closed do not and will not impose any liability or expense to the telephone company, and;

WHEREAS, the telephone company will have no use for said streets for right of way for existing and future plant. This Agreement has been executed by its Vice President and General Manager.



easements across the property as shown on your map.

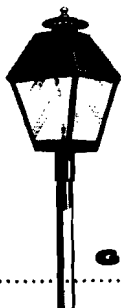
