

Below please find a chart which shows the combined 2016 and 2017 crime data, pulled from JPD RPS software. The Multifamily housing file is maintained in the Engineering department. Multifamily housing is defined in this study as a dwelling which has more than one residential unit.

Crime was overlaid in a map with the Multifamily housing. Any crime that overlapped with Multifamily housing was deemed to be "Multifamily Housing Related Crime," labeled "Multifamily." The remainder of the incidents were labeled, "All Other." This includes Commercial and Residential crime. A spatial crime density map was created to show where clustering is occurring within the Multifamily housing crime category.

Out of a total of 27,705 incidents created, 1,887 incidents occurred in "Multifamily Housing." There is a notable difference in the ratio of Crimes Against Property (31% of All Other crime, 40% in Multifamily Housing Related Crime) and Major Crimes Against Persons (2% of All Other crime, 7% in Multifamily Housing Related Crime).
