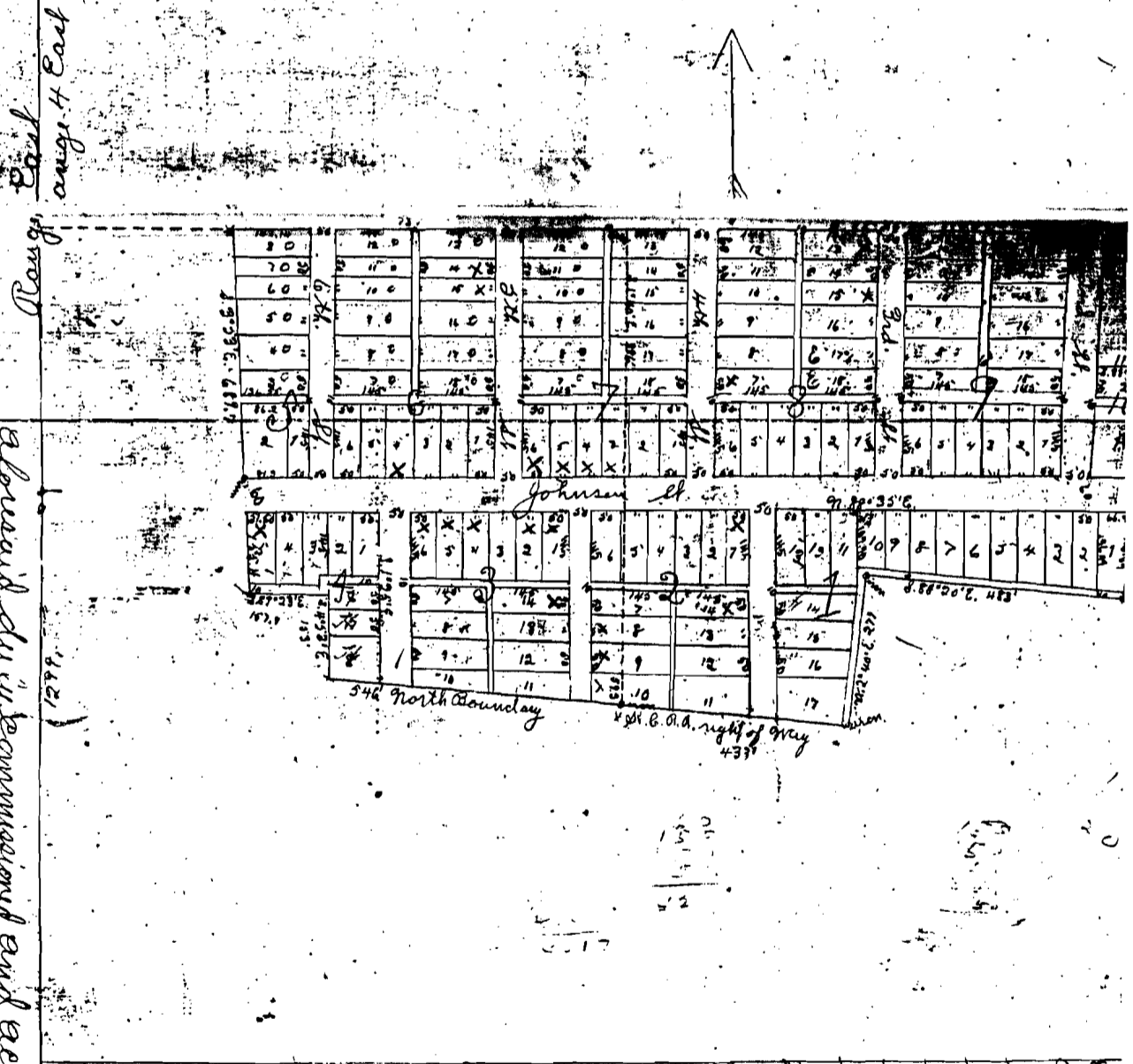

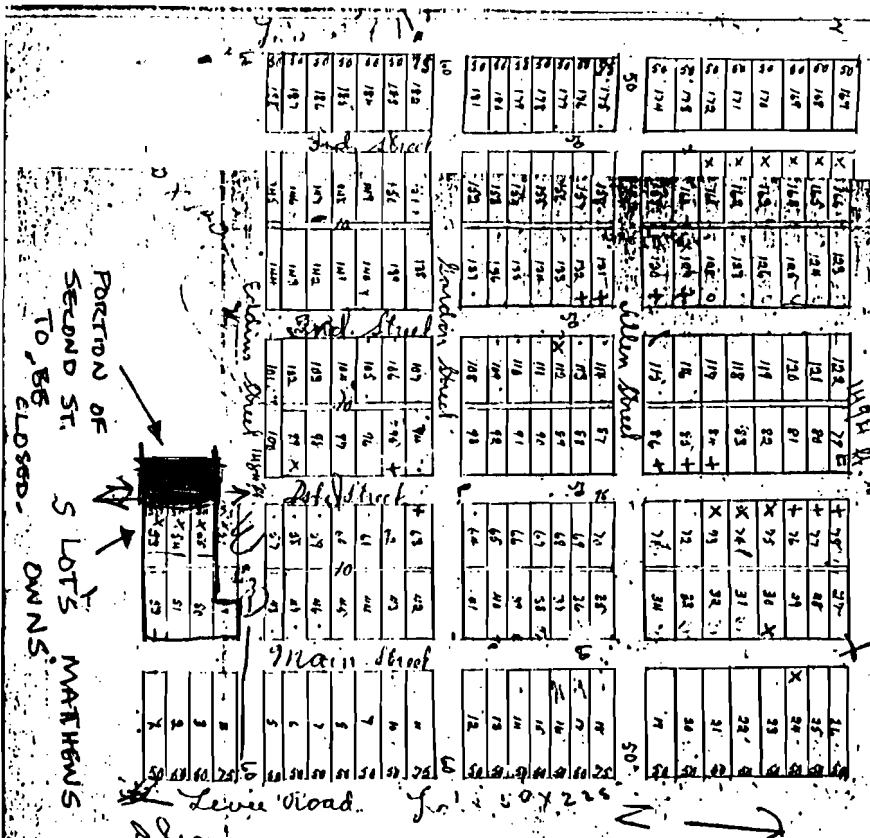

The plat hereto attached and called the Northwest Addition to the town of Jonesboro includes territory, which is more particularly described as follows: Beginning thirty (30) feet West of the Northeast corner of the North West quarter of Section Eighteen (18) in Township Fourteen (14) North, Range Four (4) East; Thence South five degrees East 1575 feet; Thence West parallel with section lines, 675 feet; Thence North 225 feet; Thence West parallel with section lines 857 feet; Thence in a northerly or northwesterly direction to a point, 1532 feet.

West of the point of beginning; Thence East 1532 feet to the point of beginning; also that strip of land on the south side of Lost Creek immediately adjoining said street which would be included in Main Street of the City of Jonesboro Arkansas, if said street were extended North to the above described property. And said land is hereby platted as an addition to the City of Jonesboro Arkansas, to be known as the Northwest Addition. And the streets and alleys designated on said plat are hereby dedicated to the public use forever.
