The home is on a pier foundation. The roof has some sagging and waving. All rafters need closely inspected and any damaged rafters, underlay, and shingles must be repaired or replaced. All windows and doors are currently boarded. The home has been boarded well over the 6-month limit set in Jonesboro city ordinance. The interior of the home is destroyed. Most of the sheet rock has been removed from the walls and ceiling. Most of the wiring has been removed from the home. The entire electrical system will have to be replaced, brought up to current building codes, and pass inspection by a city inspector.

THE HOME IS A HAZARD TO THE HEALTH, WELFARE, AND SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC. THE HOME SHOULD BE RAZED IMMEDIATELY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF LOCAL CHILDREN AND OTHER CITIZENS, NOT TO MENTION THE BLIGHT TO THE COMMUNITY. PROPERTY WAS SECURED AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION BUT PREVIOUSLY WAS NOT SECURE.
