# The Board of Directors United Artists Cablesystems Corporation:

We have applied certain agreed-upon procedures, as discussed below, to the accounting records of East Arkansas Cablevision, Inc. (the System) and to the accounting records of the Franchise Area of Jonesboro, Arkansas, (the Franchise Area) (both owned and operated by United Artists Cablesystems Corporation) (UACC) for each of the years in the three-year period ended December 31, 1989, solely to assist you in connection with your reporting to the franchising authority. It is understood that this report is solely for the information of the board of directors of UACC, managements of East Arkansas Cablevision, Inc., and the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, and is not to be referred to or distributed for any other purpose. Our procedures and findings are as follows:

#### **Procedures**

- 1. We read a copy of the Cable Data 1989 EDP Controls Review dated December 30, 1989, prepared by Deloitte and Touche. Cable Data is an independent third party that provides billing services to cable system operators.
- 2. We obtained the Monthly Subscriber Reports prepared by UACC and the applicable Cable Data reports for the month of December for each of the years in the three-year period ended December 31, 1989, reflecting basic subscriber counts at the end of each year for the System and the Franchise Area. We compared the total basic subscribers per the Monthly Subscriber Reports to the basic subscriber counts per the applicable Cable Data report.
- 3. We recalculated UACC's adjustment for Equivalent Basic Units (EBUs) as defined by UACC.
- 4. We recalculated the adjusted basic subscriber counts by adding the basic subscriber counts, as described in 2. above and the adjustment for EBUs for the System and Franchise Area, as described in 3. above for each year in the three-year period ended December 31, 1989.
- 5. We recalculated the percentage of adjusted basic subscribers in the Franchise Area to the number of adjusted basic subscribers in the System.



## **Findings**

Because our procedures do not constitute an audit made in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, we express no opinion on any of the specified items referred to above. In connection with the procedures referred to above, no matters came to our attention that caused us to believe the specified items should be adjusted. Had we performed additional procedures or had we performed an audit of the financial statements for each of the years in the three-year period ended December 31, 1989 in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported to you. This report relates only to the items specified above and does not extend to any financial statements of East Arkansas Cablevision, Inc. or the Franchise Area of Jonesboro, Arkansas, taken as a whole.
