

TO: THE HONORABLE HERBERT SANDERSON, MAYOR, AND
MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
JONESBORO, ARKANSAS

PETITION TO VACATE STREET

We, the undersigned, being the sole owners of all
property abutting upon the following described street:

Begin at the Southwest Corner of Southeast Quarter
of Southwest Quarter of Section 19, Township 14
North, Range 4 East, thence North on the West line
of Southeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter 30 feet
to the North right of way line of Highland Drive;
thence East on the aforesaid North line and parallel
to the section line 715.15 feet to the Southwest
corner of Block A of Tom Lane Addition to Jonesboro,
Arkansas, the point of beginning proper; thence
Northeasterly along the West line of aforesaid
Block A and the South and East right of way line of
Old Highway No. 39 on a $9^{\circ} 21'$ curve to the left
396.5 feet to the North corner of Block A of Tom
Lane Addition; thence Northwesterly on a curve
(radius $36'$) to the left 56.55 feet; thence West
on the North line of Block B of Tom Lane Addition
produced East a distance of 1.0 feet to the North
and West right of way line of Old Highway No. 39;
thence Southwesterly along aforesaid right of way
line on a $10^{\circ} 11'$ curve to the right 399.7 feet;
thence Southeasterly on a curve to the left
(radius of $46.04'$) a distance of 55.64 feet to
the point of beginning proper,

herewith file and present our petition to the City Council
of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, praying that said Council
vacate said street described above. In support of this
Petition, the Petitioners state that said street is no longer
needed for movement of traffic in the general area where it
is located; that it is circular in description, constituting
a part of Old State Highway No. 39 which has long since been
abandoned by the State Highway Department, and that that
portion of Old Highway No. 39 presently embraced within the
city street system has been straightened by extending
Highland Drive to Main Street so that Highland Drive inter-
sects with Main Street at right angles; that the cost of
maintenance of that portion of the street above described
by the City of Jonesboro is out of proportion to the benefits
