**5. Other Business**Update on JETS

*JETS Director Joel Gardner stated they have 50,000 riders for the year so far and the ridership continues to grow. He explained they met recently with citizens from north Jonesboro to discuss what the transit system can do to help with that area. He further explained they are hoping to have meetings to discuss the transit system with the community and how to use it.*

Lights on Bridge Street bridge

*Mr. Wilkie explained it would cost \$60,000 to redo the lighting on the bridge. He further explained a grant wouldn't fund the renovations because it would be aesthetic lighting instead of security lighting. He stated Ms. Gayle Vickers from CDBG is looking into demolishing some of the homes around the bridge to clean it up. Discussion was held concerning the lighting in the stairwell. Mr. Tony Thomas stated he didn't think there would be any problem with the stairwell or underneath the bridge; rather, the problems were just with the lights on top of the bridge where there is already lighting existing. Councilman Hargis suggested putting together a design that shows exactly what they want done to the bridge and to put the project out to bid. Mr. Wilkie noted the Historic Register has a grant department that could possibly help with grant money but the bridge would have to be put on the historic register. Mr. Thomas also noted they've been working with the Arkansas Department of Economic Development to gather more information about other grants.*
