Mayor Brodell:

Industrial Track Agreement BN-27696 dated July 7, 1989, between the City of Jonesboro and Burlington Northern Railroad covers the construction, maintenance, operation, and ownership of a 7,000 foot lead track (Phase I) serving the Jonesboro Industrial Park at Jonesboro, Arkansas.

The City has constructed over 2 miles of additional track (11,233 feet known as Phase II) with plans for more track construction as part of Phase III. Over the past two years I have made several attempts to secure a supplemental agreement to include Phase II trackage as a part of the original industrial track agreement. I have not received any response.

Phase II and III track extensions are a contiguous and uninterrupted part of the 7,000 foot lead track covered by Industrial Track Agreement BN-27696. We consider this lead track, as extended from time to time, subject to the same terms and conditions as Phase I.

Please indicate the City's agreement to extend the terms and conditions of Industrial Track Agreement BN-27696 to the entire track, including Phase II and III, by signing in the space provided and returning one copy to me.
