The structure in on a slab foundation with a block exterior. The structure is in a severe state od disrepair. Most of the roof has fallen in. The entire roof must be replaced. All windows and doors are either broken or boarded. All windows and door must be repaired or replaced. The interior was not inspected due to safety concerns. The entire soffit area is rotten or has fallen off. The entire electrical system of the structure must be repaired and brought up to current state codes, inspected, and approved by the city's inspectors prior to having service restored. The entire plumbing system of the structure must be repaired and brought up to current state code, inspected and approved by the city's inspectors prior to having service restored. There is junk spread around most of the rear of the property.

CURRENTLY THE STRUCTURE IS A HAZARD TO THE HEALTH, WELFARE, AND SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC. THE STRUCTURE SHOULD BE RAZED IMMEDIATELY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF LOCAL CHILDREN AND OTHER CITIZENS, NOT TO MENTION THE BLIGHT TO THE COMMUNITY. PROPERTY WAS NOT SECURED AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION.
