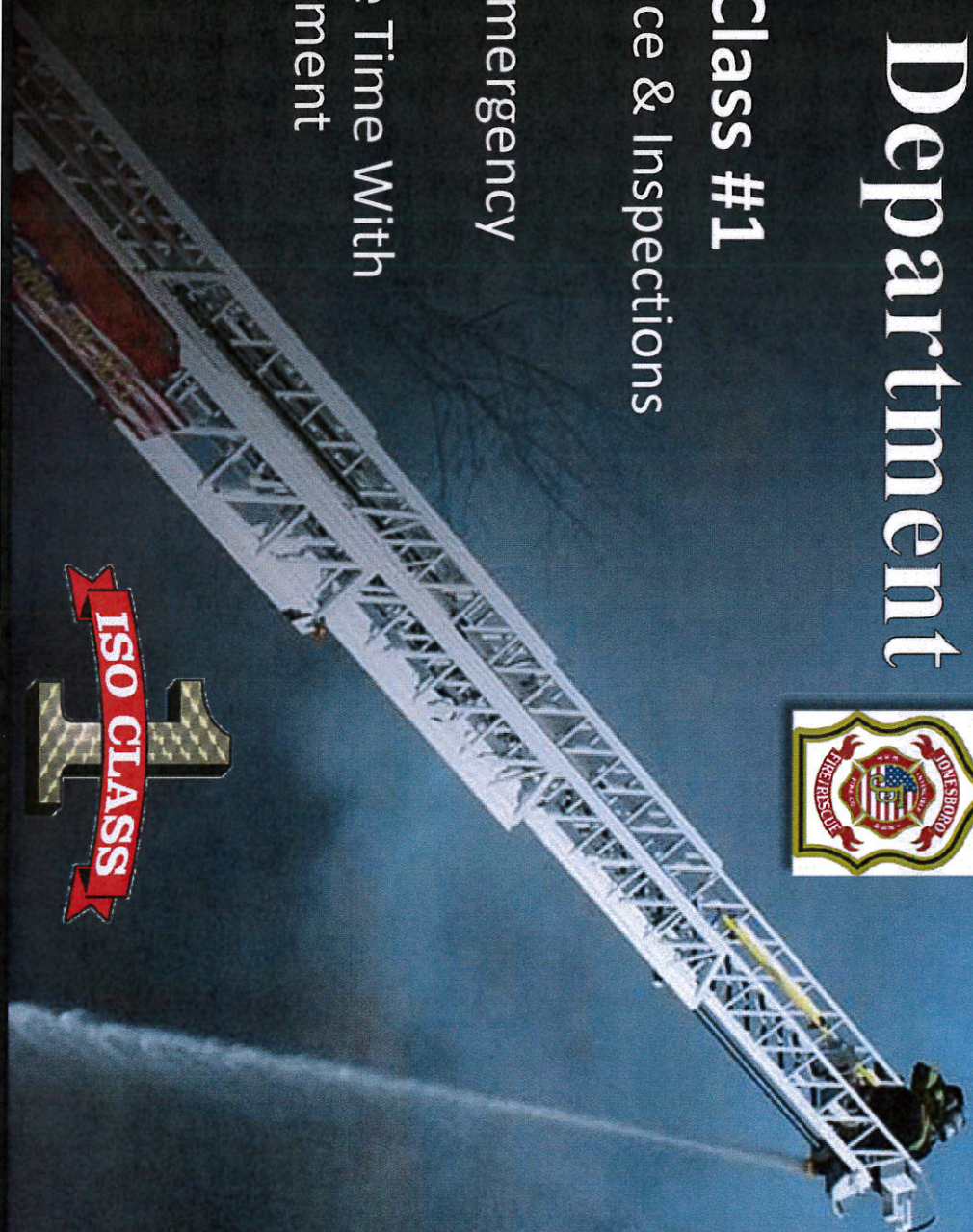

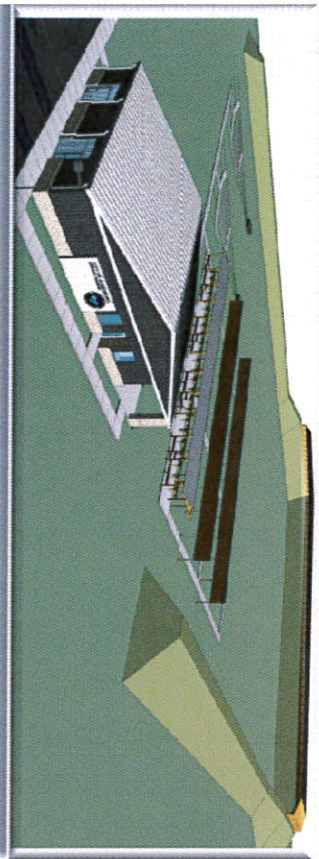
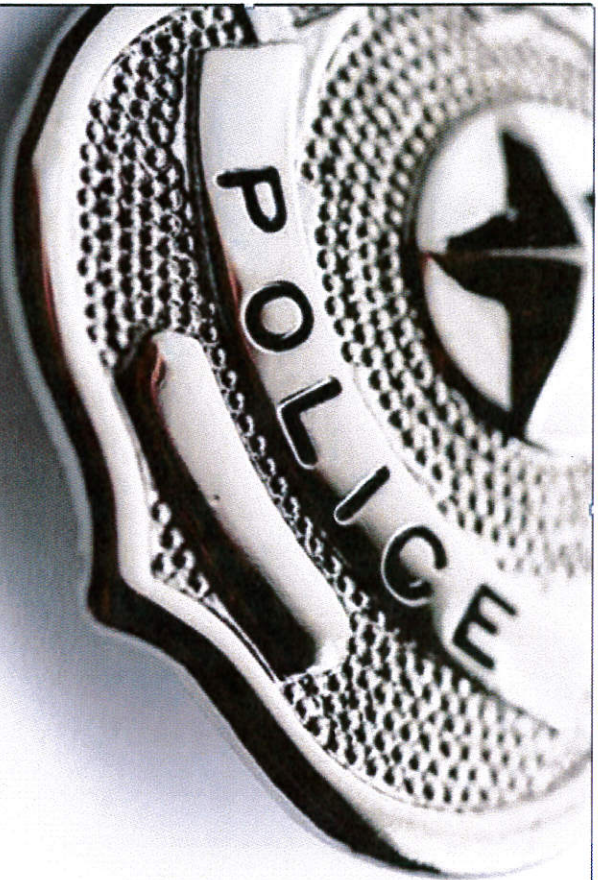


Fire Department

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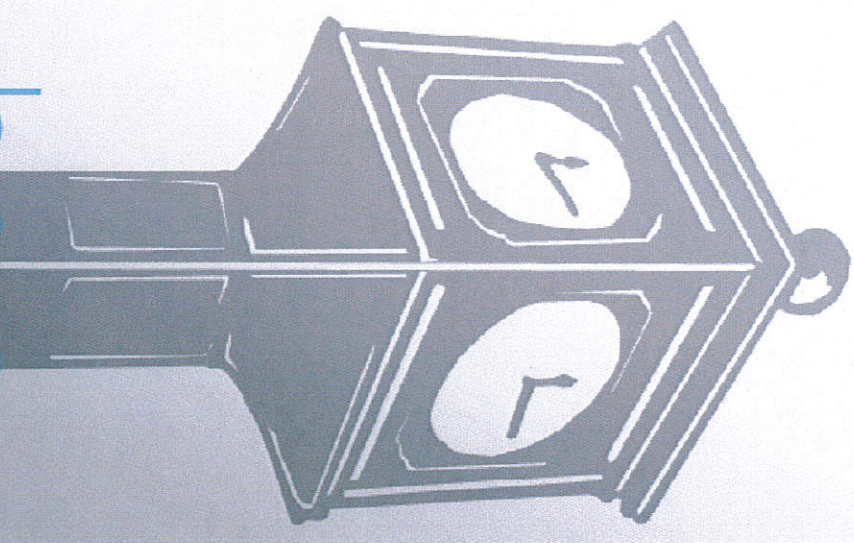


The Sanitation Department

- Incinerated Approximately 7,500 Tons



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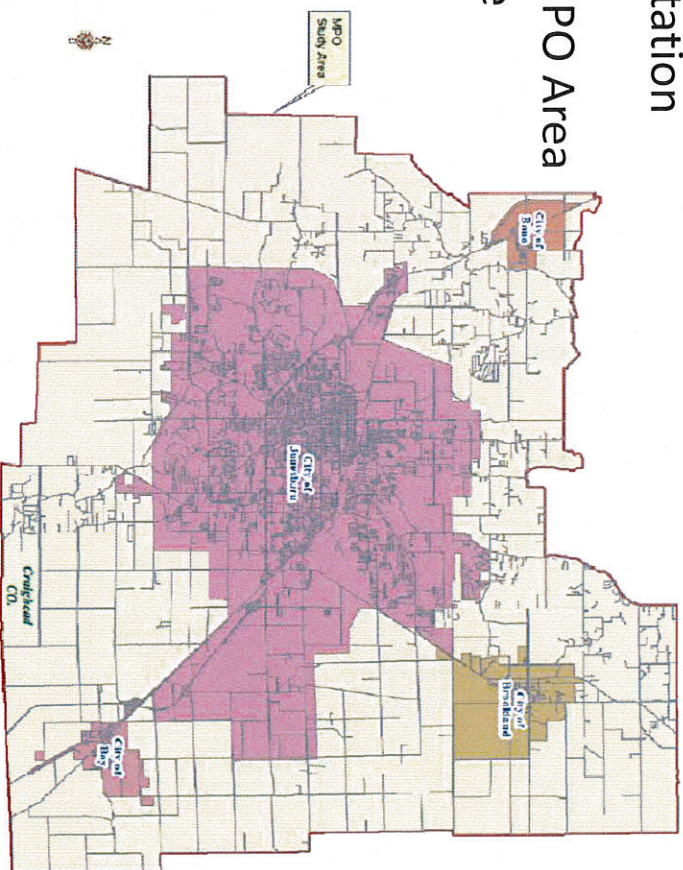




Jonesboro MPO

- Completed Bicycle/Pedestrian Studies For The Downtown Area And Johnson Avenue



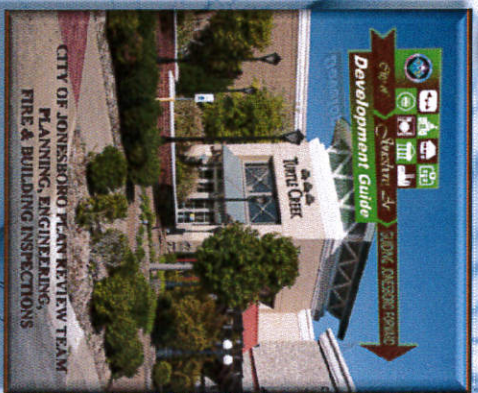


Grants Department

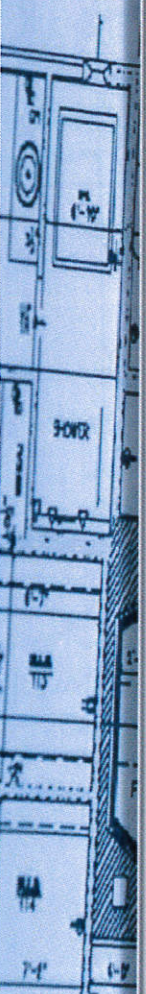
- Received Two Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) Grants Totaling \$468,193

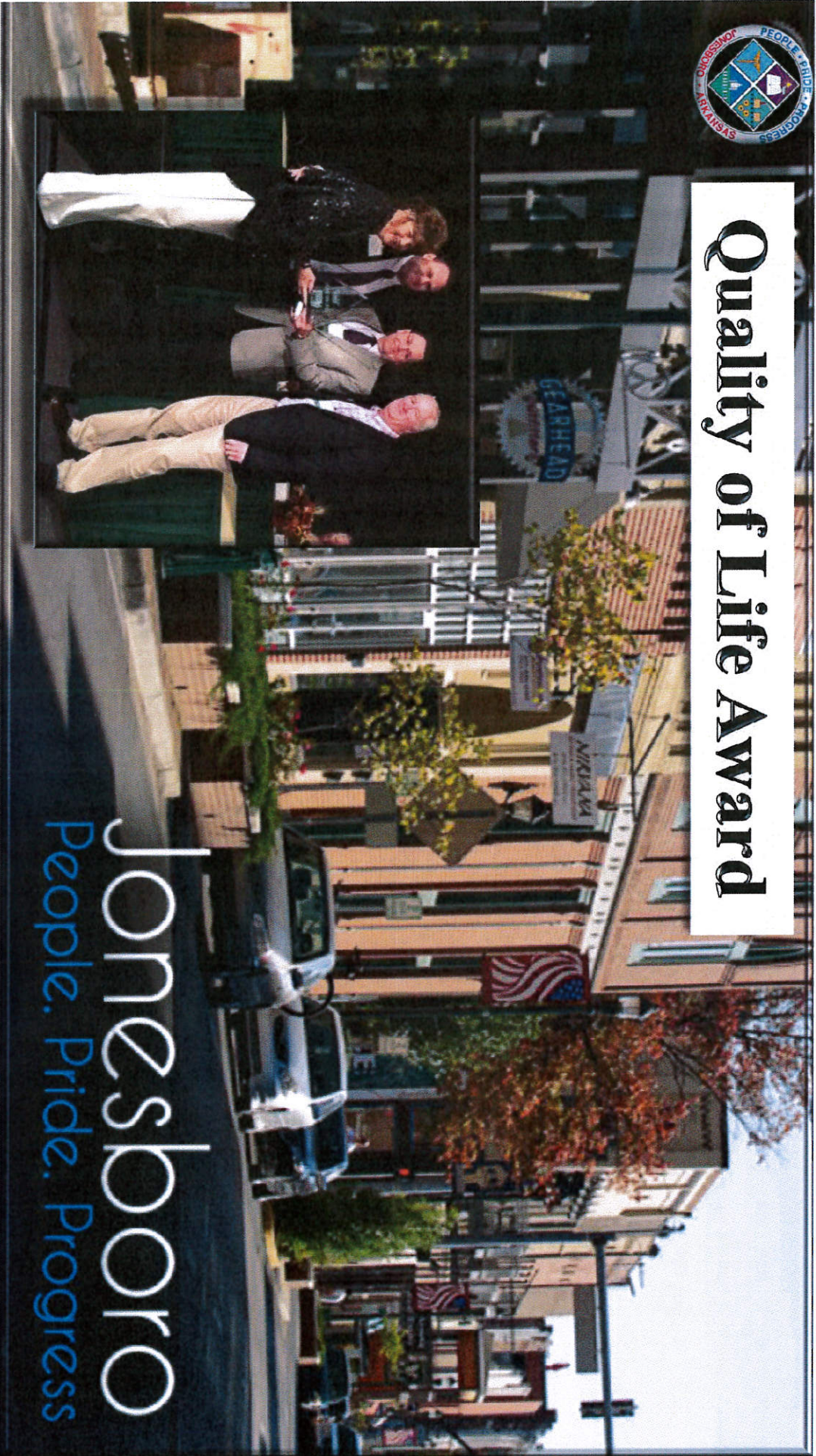
- Phase II Race Street Drainage Project

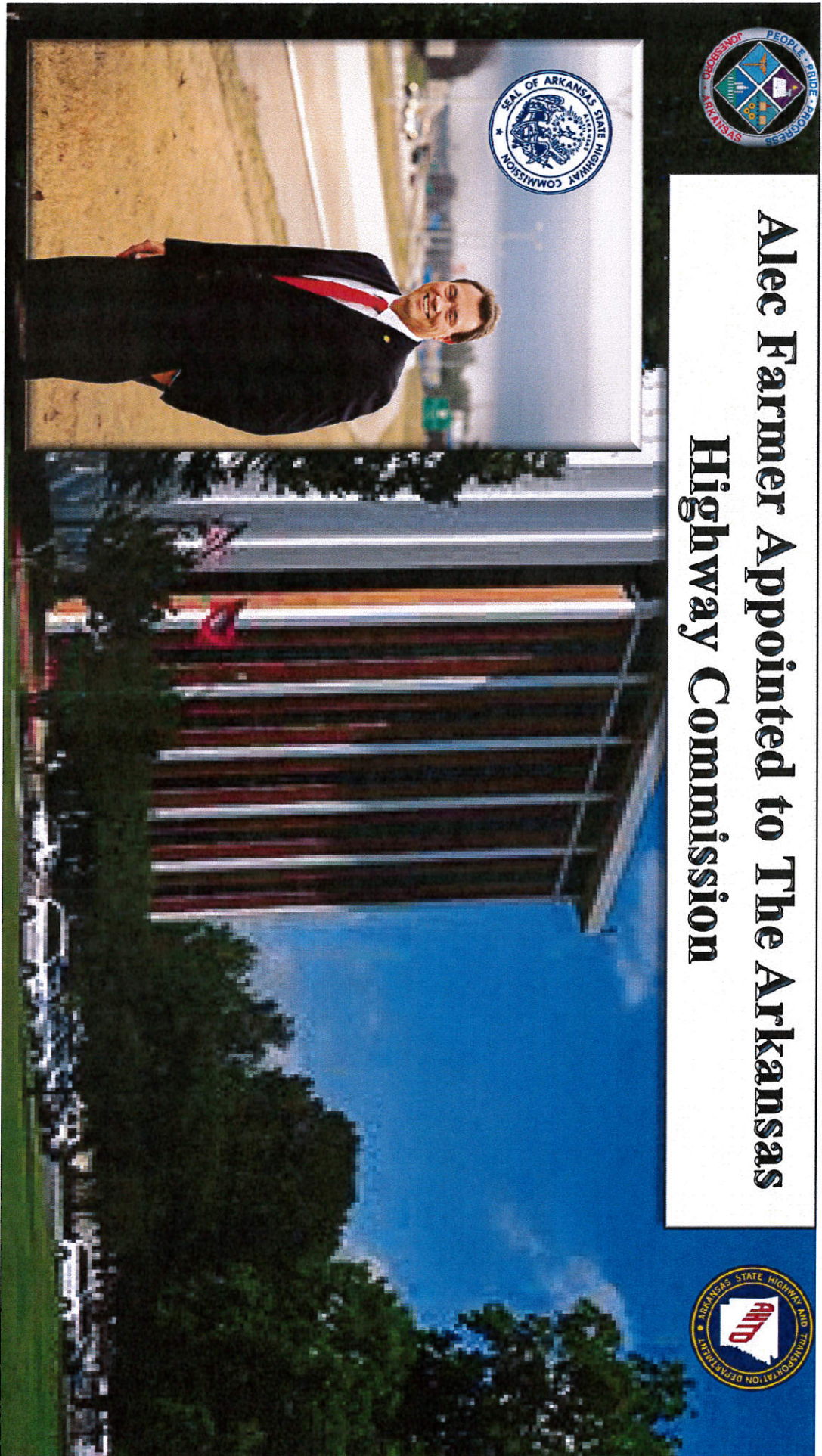


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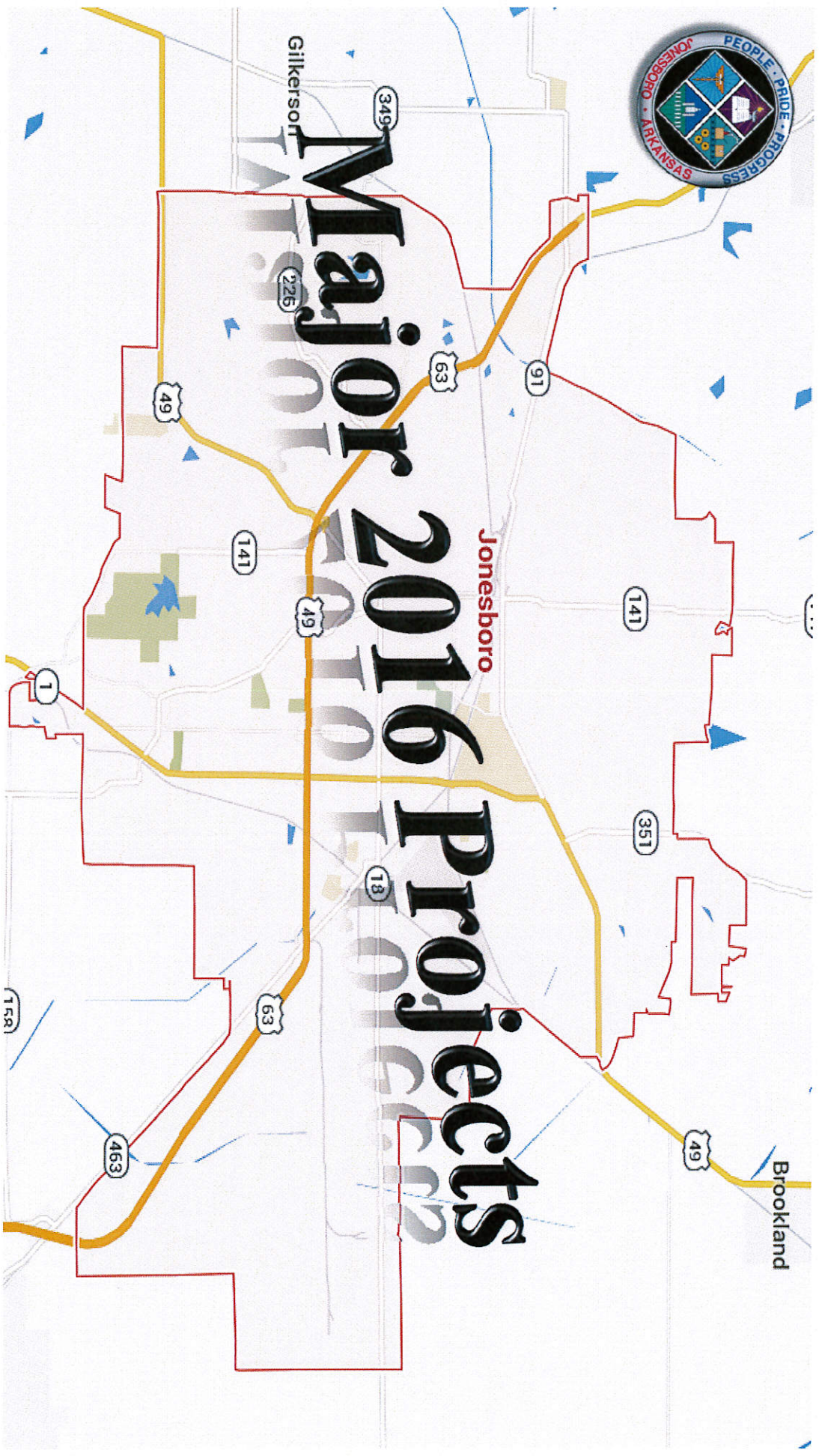

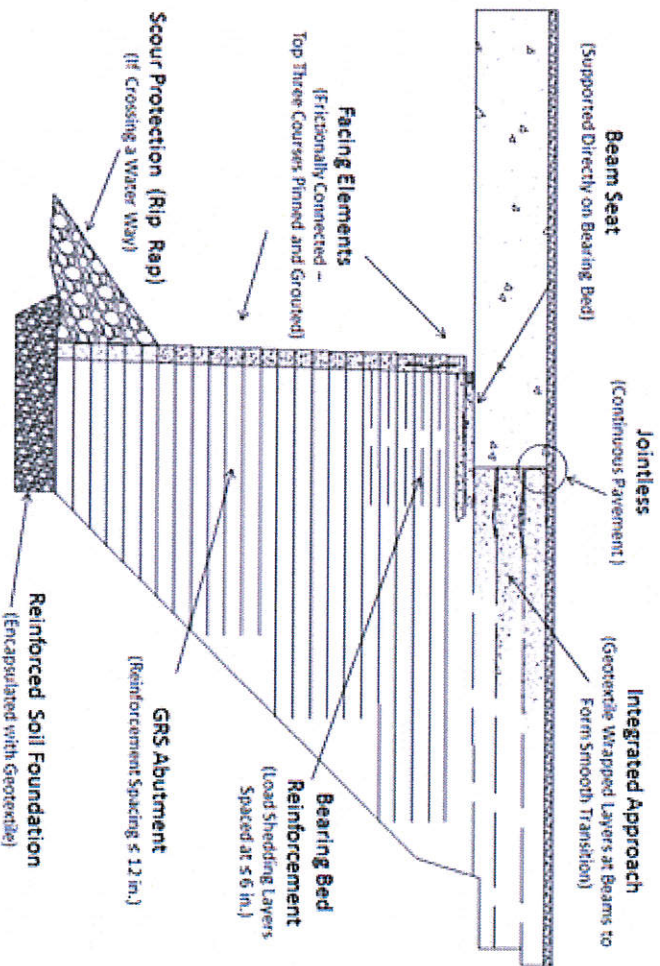


Innovative Bridge Project

- Currently Working on Design and Utility Adjustments



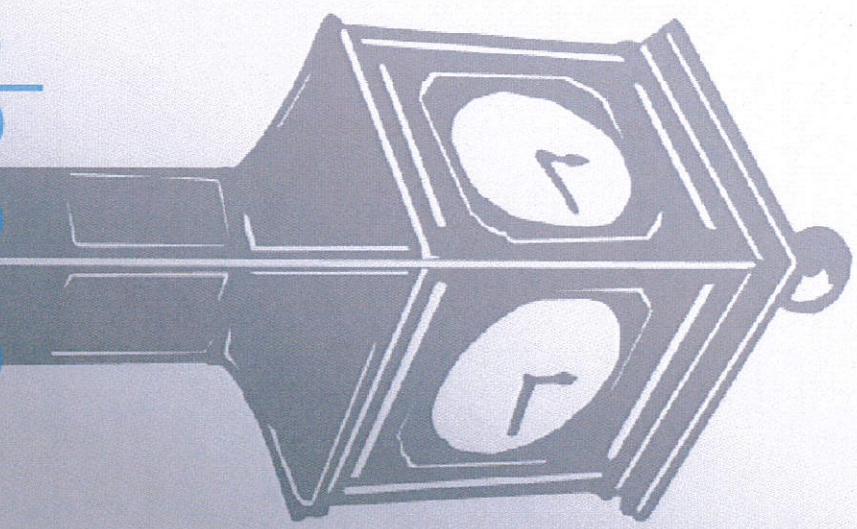


Parker Road Extension

- Estimated Completion March 2017

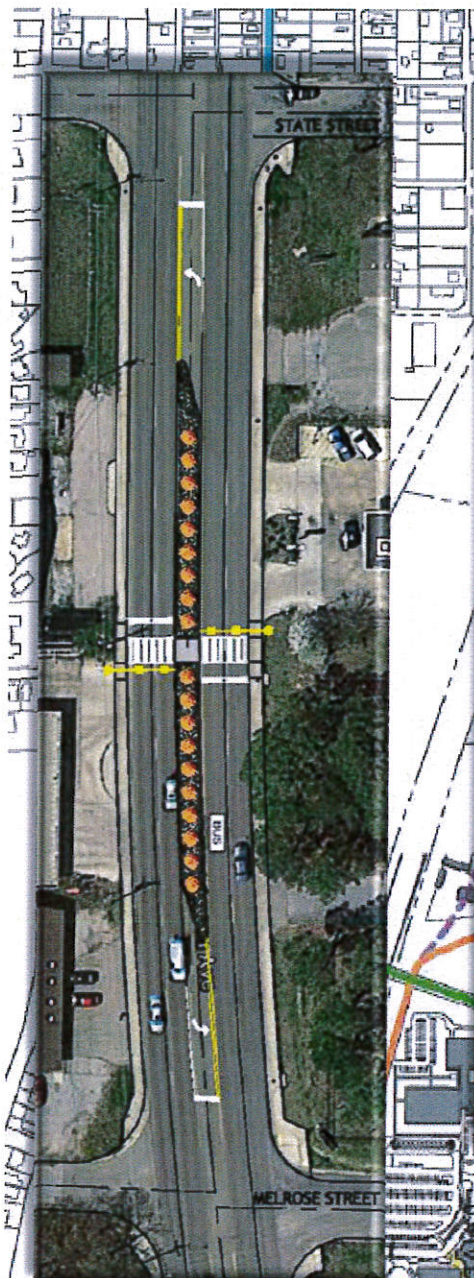
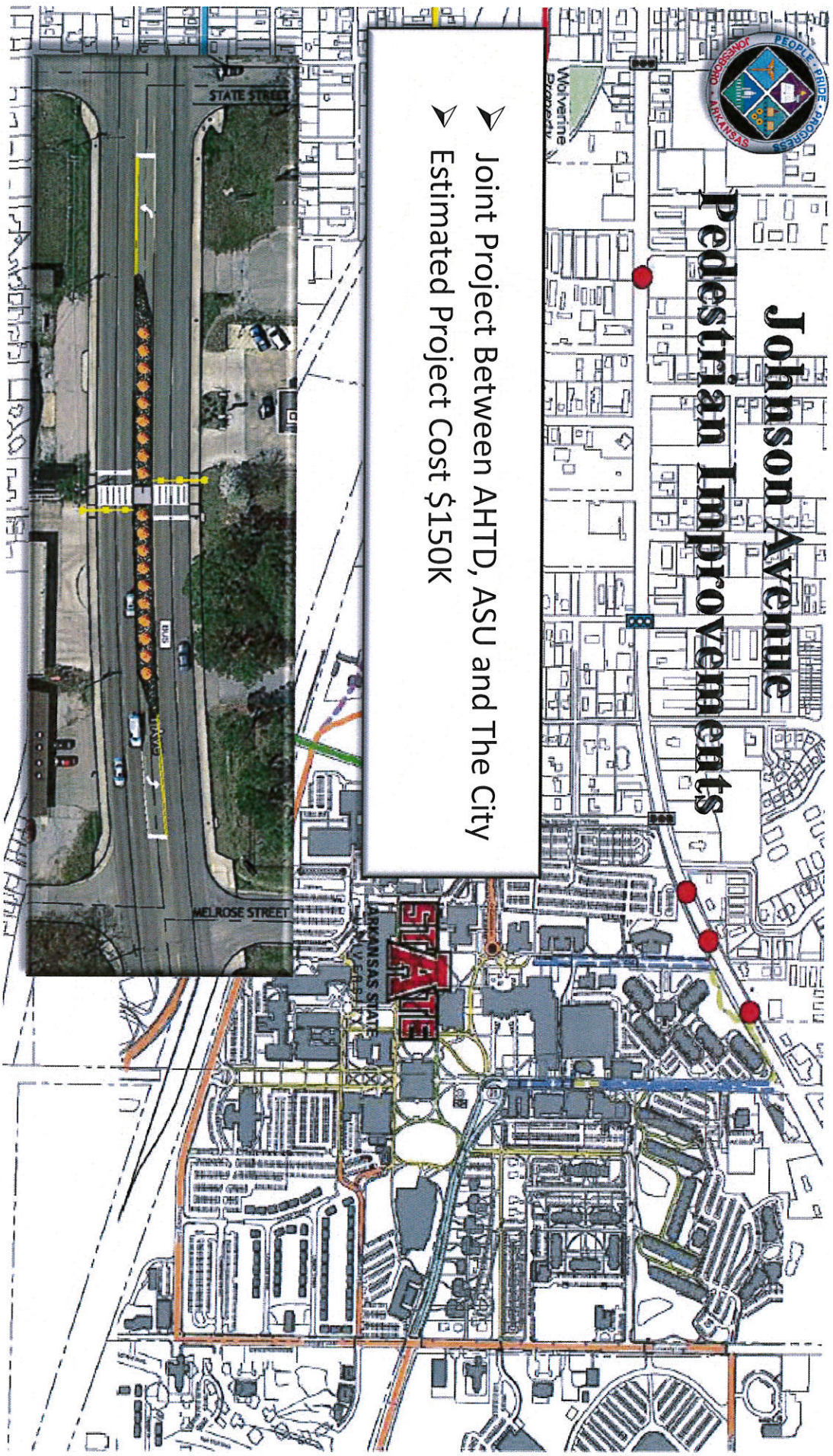
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Johnson Avenue Pedestrian Improvements

- Estimated Project Cost \$1500K

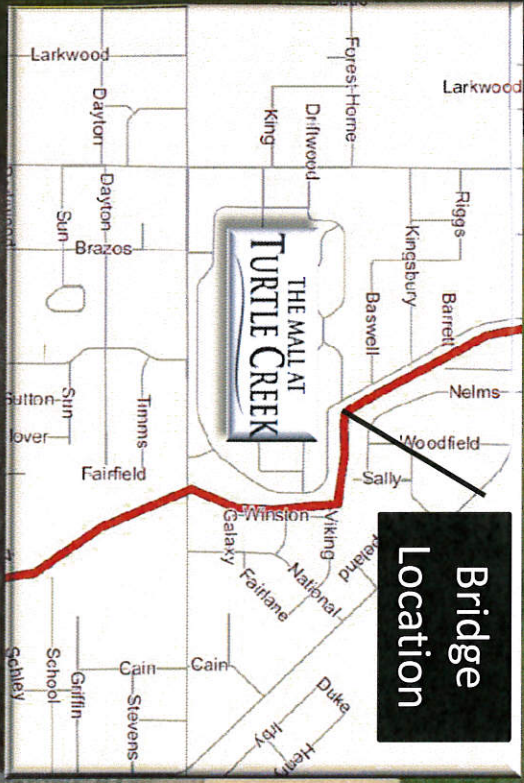
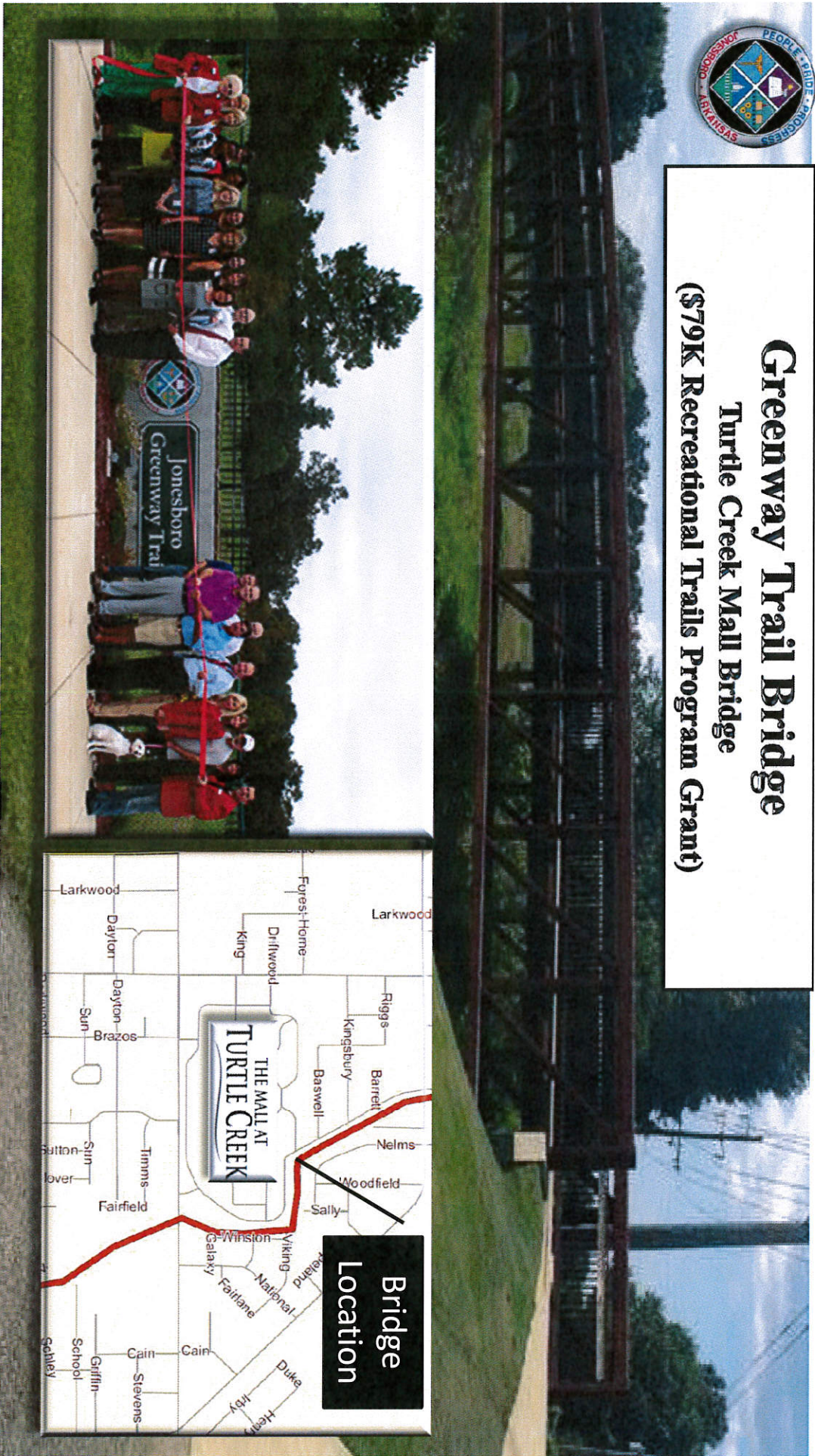

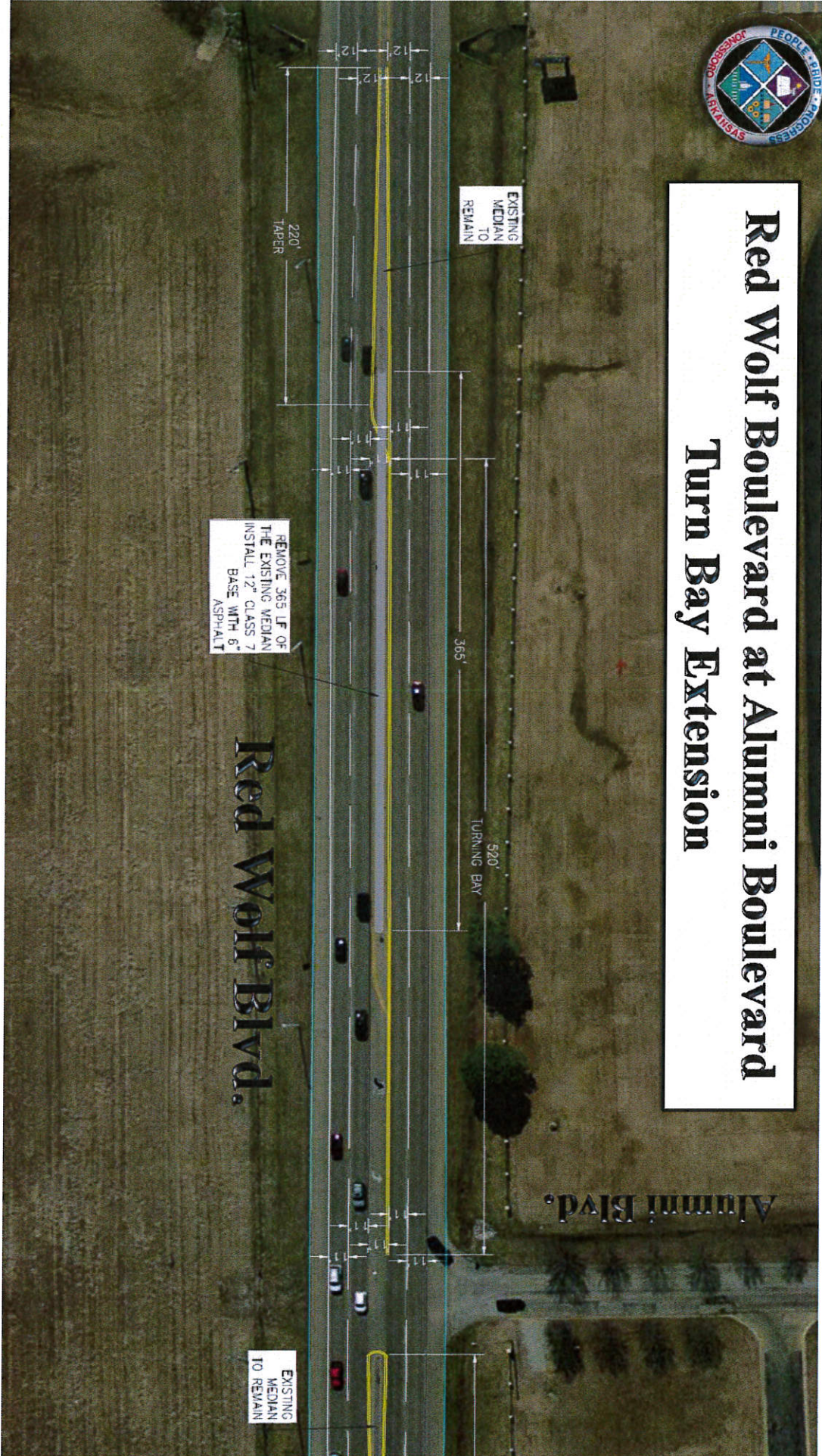

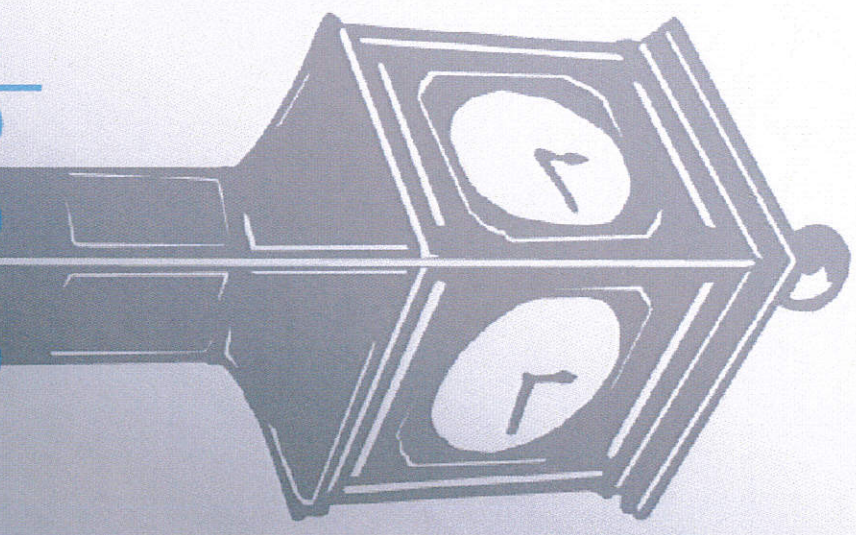


Airport Road and Aggie Road Roundabout

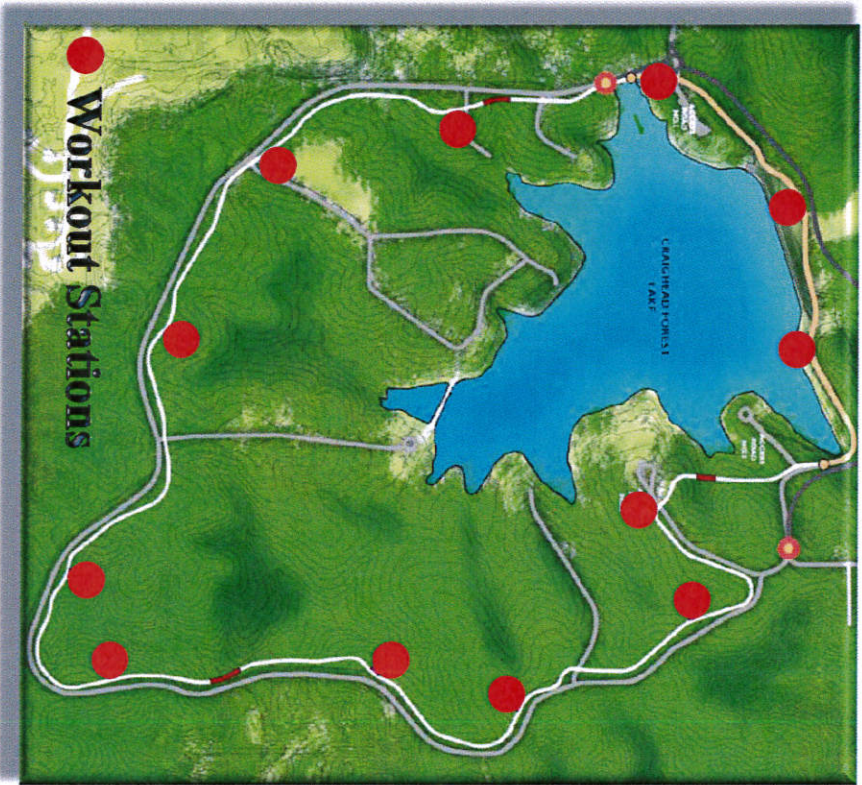
