









WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, William S. Ellis and Elizabeth Hatman Ellis, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000.00) Dollars paid and to be paid as follows, to-wit:

Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars to us in hand paid by the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars payable on the 1st day of February of each year for sixteen (16) years, the first being due and payable on February 1, 1965, and the last being due and payable on February 1, 1980, and Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars being due and payable on February 1, 1981, all of said payments evidenced by Certificates of Indebtedness numbered 49 through 65, inclusive, a vendor's

lien being retained for the payment of the deferred installments,
do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said City of Jonesboro, Arkansas,
and unto its successors and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the County
of Craighead, City of Jonesboro, and State of Arkansas, to-wit:

Lots 2 and 3 in Block "A" of the Original Survey of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, the same being a lot approximately 120 ft. by 120 ft.


The above Certificates of Indebtedness are issued pursuant to Ordinance No. 998 of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, Section 3 (a), passed, approved and adopted on November 16, 1959, and bear interest at the rate of $5\frac{1}{2}$ percent per annum, the interest being due and payable on all Certificates of Indebtedness on February 1 and August 1 of each year until they are all paid in full. The Grantors have all rights granted to them pursuant to said Ordinance.

To have and to hold the same unto the said City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, and unto its successors and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And we hereby covenant with the said City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, that we will forever warrant and defend the title to the said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Elizabeth Hatman Ellis, wife of the said William S. Ellis, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, all of my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
