THE HOME IS ON A PIER FOUNDATION. THE BRICK AND MORTER ARE CRACKED, LOOSE, AND MISSING IN MANY PLACES AROUND THE HOME. THERE IS RED DIRT BEING HAULED INTO THE HOME TO FILL IN THE PIER FOUNDATION BUT NO PERMITS HAVE BEEN ISSUED FOR THE PROPERTY. THE ENTIRE FRONT WALL OF THE PROPERTY IS LOOSE FROM THE FOUNDATION AND MOVES IF PUSHED ON. NONSTRUCTUAL BRACES ARE SUPPORTING THE FRONT PORCH AND EXTERIOR WALLS TO PREVENT THEM FROM FALLING DOWN. THERE IS PLUMBING BEING COMPLETED ALSO WITHOUT PERMITS. ALL WINDOWS AND DOORS ARE EITHER BROKEN OR MISSING. THE ENTIRE HOME IS UNSAFE. THE HOME IS A HAZARD TO THE HEALTH, WELFARE, AND SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC. THE HOME SHOULD BE RAZED IMMEDIATELY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF LOCAL CHILDREN AND OTHER CITIZENS, NOT TO MENTION THE BLIGHT TO THE COMMUNITY. PROPERTY WAS NOT SECURED AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION.
