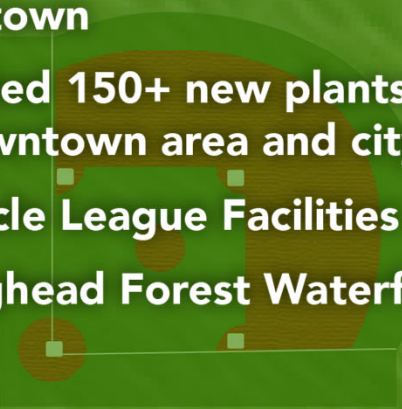


- 7,482 calls for service

# PARKS



- opened Shooting Sports Complex
- burial logs from 1950's - 2022 made digitally accessible
- installed 1st cigarette butt containers downtown
- planted 150+ new plants/shrubs & 44 trees to downtown area and city parks
- Miracle League Facilities floors updated
- Craighead Forest Waterfall installed



- upgraded rock wall feature at Earl Bell
- upgraded community centers to LED lighting
- over \$62,000 in sponsorship revenue
- new signage placed throughout Craighead Forest Park
- 11,593 participants in recreational programs
- 1,119 teams participated in tournaments





# GRANTS

- \$9,223,339 in grants awarded

- Union Street Park grant


# PLANNING
