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#### **COMMENTS MADE AT THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING 9/16/2014**

Honorable Mayor and City Council Members, my name is Tom Reeves. I have been a resident of Jonesboro since we retired in 1999 and moved here in 2000.

I strongly oppose Jonesboro's Greensboro Village Town Center (the "Village") because it is wrong for Jonesboro – and for our country. Stated in its simplest form it is part of a nation-wide "Regionalism" plan to silence voters AND our local officials (*that's YOU!*) so that unelected regional officials can dictate what happens in our local area – *designed to remove accountability to voters*.

If you do not understand that Regionalism plan and how the Village is a part of it, you will not be representing Jonesboro's citizens if you approve the Village without that understanding. *If you have an understanding of that Regionalism plan and if you approve the Village, then you will have violated the trust and confidence of the citizens of Jonesboro in the worst possible way.* 

The Village, is receiving very negative national publication; that alone is not in Jonesboro's best interest.

You have heard a lot of opposition addressed toward the zoning, traffic, congestion, increased crime, etc. *the inescapable results of approving projects such as the Village*. So I'm going to direct my comments toward a different topic *that has received very little attention, primarily to give you some questions I believe you need to consider*.

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## (1) EDUCATIONAL BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE:

It makes me very uncomfortable to say what I am about to say because I am not a self-touting person; however, I believe it would be beneficial for you to be aware of the experience from which I speak. I am an attorney, member of the State Bar of Texas; my status is retired. I am a Certified Public Accountant in the States of Mississippi and Texas, retired status also.

## (a) **EXPERIENCE EVALUATION NEW BUSINESS:**

I spent more than 35 years working for one of the largest multi-national corporations in the world. *I was fortunate. I had a fascinating and challenging career.* Early into my career I was chosen to participate in the economic evaluation of some of the largest pipelines in the world, including the Trans-Alaskan Pipeline System, the purchase of businesses that would be included in the Fortune 500 and countless other multi-million dollar projects.

## (b) **EXPERIENCE WITH GOVERNMENTAL REGULATION:**

I spent about one third of my career coping with a multitude of onerous U.S. Government regulations, involving compliance and litigation.

#### (C) **EXPERIENCE WITH CONTRACTS and CREDIT:**

During the last one-third of my career I was involved in the management of contracts, credit and securities, *where security was required*, for transactions with well over 2,000 companies all over the world. I was involved in the negotiation, preparation and review of approximately 5,000 contracts per year. I negotiated,

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and arranged countless securities over the years and monitored our business to ensure that our transactions were always sufficiently secured.

## (d) **EXPERIENCE WITH SECURITIES and BANKRUPTCIES:**

One of my responsibilities during the last one-third of my career was to protect our company from loss due to bankruptcy of our customers. *I received no special recognition for it, nor did I expect any, because it was my job. It has always a matter of personal pride with me, but we did not lose one penny during my 12-year tenure.* I have seen many companies ruined by theft, defalcations, greed, mismanagement and debt they could not pay. Attempts to deceive were ever present. *In various ways* I was involved in many high profile multi-million dollar bankruptcies, including Enron.

## (e) **EXPERIENCE WITH ENRON'S BANKRUPTCY:**

Our company was the first to require Enron to secure their transactions. We were ridiculed for requiring such a "successful" company secure their transactions, but when Enron's bankruptcy occurred they were beating a path to our door asking "How did you see Enron's bankruptcy coming?" All we could tell them was, "We had access to the same information you had. We probably paid more attention to it than you did and we asked ourselves some penetrating questions, like where are Enron's assets? What is the nature of those assets? We did some simple thinking 'outside the box' – like, if you cannot find the assets do they exist? We concluded Enron's assets didn't exist, which proved to be true." To protect Jonesboro's taxpayers from loss the City Council must pay attention to unpopular details and view opposition with open minds.

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#### (2) ONE AGENDA 21 COMMENT:

I will make only one comment regarding Agenda 21 and that is that *the Village is a classic Agenda 21 (3P) public-private partnership – it has every characteristic*. At least one Village developer has a very serious conflict of interest and a strong tie to *Jonesboro's Vision 2030*, which *began as a verbatim Agenda 21 document*, *notwithstanding denials that it was.* To approve the Village *with knowledge of that credibility taint and* without a thorough understanding of the *United Nations' Agenda 21* connection by the City Council fails to protect the citizens of Jonesboro, whose best interest it is your responsibility to protect and defend.

#### (3) EXCESSIVE COST OF THE VILLAGE IS A WARNING TO YOU:

The excessive cost of the Village is a warning to you. A disproportionate share of the public-private partnerships across the U.S. have failed. One of the most prevalent characteristics in 3Ps is that the 'private investors' go bankrupt mid-way through the project leaving taxpayers 'on the hook' and city leaders with significant problems to deal with. *The excessive cost of the Village, about three times what it should be, should be a warning to you. That emphatically says to me, as it should to you, "Something is not right!"* It's so blatant you cannot ignore it.

#### (4) **QUESTIONS FOR MAYOR PERRIN AND THE CITY COUNCIL:**

About the only thing I have time to do is leave some questions about Jonesboro's *Greensboro Village (the* "Village") with you that you should consider. *There are a lot of justifiable concerns about the Village and* the worst thing you could do to

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the City of Jonesboro is rush to judgment with those questions outstanding. Some of them are:

- 1. Do the developers and private investors have sufficient unencumbered assets to complete the Village?
- 2. If so, what assurance does the City Council have that those unencumbered assets will continue to be available until the Village is complete?
- 3. Has the City Council made enforceable arrangements with the developers and owners of the 'private investors' to ensure that they do not drain their corporations' financial capabilities through excessive salaries and bonuses during completion of the Village – thereby forcing those entities into bankruptcy?
- 4. Has the City Council required all the developers and private investors to personally and corporately indemnify the City of Jonesboro and its taxpayers from loss of any kind associated with completion of the Village?
- 5. Has the City Council required the developers and private investors to provide sufficient security, prior to City Council approval (preferred) of or beginning of construction, of the Village? With:
  - a. Letters of Credit in an amount, in a format, for a time period and by a bank or banks acceptable to the City Council? Or other security acceptable to the City Council, e.g.,

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- b. Prepayments acceptable to the City Council?
- c. Posting of assets of a type and amount acceptable to the City Council?

If the Private Partners are not willing to personally indemnify and adequately secure the City of Jonesboro and its taxpayers against loss that should be a warning to the City Council *that their capabilities and/or intentions are impure.* 

- 6. Have any of the developers or 'private investors' declared personal or corporate bankruptcy in the past? And if so, what assurance does the City Council have that they can complete the Village without doing so again?
- 7. If any or all of the 'private investors' become bankrupt at any time during construction of the Village, what are the City Council's plans for completing the Village? And who pays for its completion?
- 8. Do any members of the City Council members have any direct or indirect financial interest in the construction and/or completion of the Village?
- 9. If the City Council is so certain that the City of Jonesboro and its taxpayers will not incur a loss as a result of implementing the Village, are each and all of the City Council members willing to personally indemnify the City of Jonesboro and its taxpayers against loss? And provide adequate security to protect taxpayers from loss?

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> If the City Council is not willing to personally indemnify and adequately secure the City of Jonesboro and its taxpayers against loss, what would you think that says to Jonesboro residents?

10.If the City Council has been negligent in protecting the City of Jonesboro in any of the above mentioned ways, how can the Council expect the public to believe they do not have an improper personal financial or seriously conflicting interest in the Village?

No matter what degree of trust you may have in the Village developers and/or private investors, *in today's environment* it is not prudent to enter into transactions like the Village without adequate security for the full and complete performance of all the developers and/or private investors.

## (5) A PERFECT, RISK-FREE PROJECT SHIFTS RISK OF LOSS:

Of all the economic evaluations I have been involved in I have never seen a single one that did not have at least one significant factor mitigating against starting the project. Yet what we have seen from the *developers* does not mention a single downside risk, which can only mean that, *insofar as the "private investors" are concerned*, they *see it as a* perfect, *risk-free project*. *That can only be true if they have shifted their risks to someone other than themselves*, and that "someone" can only be the City of Jonesboro and its taxpayers.

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#### (6) THE PRIVATE INVESTOR IMPLICATION:

We keep hearing: "Private investors are funding the project and assuming the risks." That is not *the least bit* impressive *to independent thinkers*. The implication is that 'if a private investor is involved in a project that investor has the financial capability to complete it.' Enron was a 'private investor.' Enron's CEO (*Kenneth Lay*) touted Enron's so-called 'financial success;' *so did many institutional investors holding their stock*. The institutional investors were so enamored with Enron's "success" they did not take the time to perform the due diligence they should have performed and their negligence caused significant losses to thousands of people *all across the U.S.* 

In all of my years of experience with the bankruptcies I have dealt with I have never met a single "private investor" who would tell you their financial capability was insufficient or in jeopardy. As a matter of fact, it is a classic characteristic of a doubtful entity to tout their capability; the more they brag about their ability to succeed, the less likely they are to be able to do so. Successful companies don't have to brag. Their achievements speak for them.

There is a lot of "bragging," but precious little reliable information, being provided by the Village's developers and private investors. That should be a HUGE red flag to the City Council. I would be less than honest if I told you I see the recognition of those dangers.

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#### (7) EXPERTS SAY "NO 3Ps FOR HOUSING OR MASS TRANSIT":

To protect cities and their taxpayers from loss, the experts recommend that "3Ps should not be allowed for funding housing projects or mass transit systems without clear disclosure of the costs and taxpayer obligations over 40 years and full vote of approval by the citizens." That is the exact opposite of what we are seeing.

#### (8) THANK YOU FOR LISTENING AND FOR THE OPPORTUNITY:

Thank you for your time and for listening to what I had to say. I request that you deny approval of the Village completely. It is not in Jonesboro's best interest and never will be. I also request that you allow Jonesboro's voters the opportunity to approve or disapprove the Village. *I believe that would be in your best interest. It would certainly remove a lot of very serious concerns many of Jonesboro's citizens have.* 

#### END OF PRESENTATION – TIME APPROXIMATELY 5 MINUTES

Comments in bold blue italics above are comments I would have made to the City Council if I had been allowed the time to do so. Those comments are included in this document for the record and for availability to the City Council members and others who may have an interest in reading them.

Bold amber comments above were shown during the KAIT-8 News program on the afternoon of Tuesday, September 16, 2014.

*Bold Green comments published in the Jonesboro Sun, September 17, 2014.* Comments and information that follow are relevant to and/or support comments made during the presentation; the information was not presented at the meeting.

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#### ADDITIONAL COMMENTS AND INFORMATION FOR THE RECORD:

As I sat and listened to the various speakers at the January 28, 2013 City Planning meeting what I heard was a lot of people telling our city officials that they are headed in a direction opposite of that in which it should be going. I heard people telling you, "Jonesboro Vision 2030 is a foreign plan, not only in its origin, but in its relationship to the citizens of Jonesboro, Arkansas."

#### (1) **LACK OF FAMILIARITY WITH U.N. AGENDA 21:** During the course

of the January 28, 2013 city planning meeting the planners were asked, "How many of you are familiar with Agenda 21." The planners readily admitted they had no familiarity with Agenda 21, with the exception of a young lady named Heather and one other who said they had been doing some reading on Agenda 21. Yet the 'planners' insisted that "Jonesboro Vision 2030 is NOT Agenda 21." If Jonesboro's city planners were totally unfamiliar with Agenda 21, how do they know Jonesboro Vision 2030 is "not Agenda 21?" Their statements were therefore inconsistent and are not credible. There is no other conclusion.

## (2) JONESBORO VISION 2030 IS U.N. AGENDA 21: The city planners acknowledge that concentration of population presents significant problems for any city. Chief Yates made that comment during his presentation. Yet one of Agenda 21's primary goals is to concentrate the world's population into tightly packed areas – Agenda 21 proponents call it "Stack 'Em and

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Pack 'Em." *Jonesboro Vision 2030 IS Agenda 21*. Jonesboro's Greensboro Village is an Agenda 21 "Stack 'Em and Pack 'Em" in the purest form.

One of the ladies who spoke during the meeting pointed out provision after provision in Jonesboro Vision 2030 that were, in essence, direct, verbatim quotations directly out of United Nations' Agenda 21. Denial of that proven fact generated distrust, on the part of Jonesboro's population, of Jonesboro's City Plans. If Jonesboro's planners cannot be honest with themselves and Jonesboro's residents, then Jonesboro has no plans that Jonesboro residents will accept.

(3) "CONTROL" IS UNDENIABLY AGENDA 21: During the course of the meeting one of the city's planners made the comment that *Jonesboro Vision 2030's objective is "control." "Control" IS undeniably Agenda 21* and Jonesboro's residents are not only going to resist 'control,' but will distrust Jonesboro's plans and will not support them. Try forcing those "control" plans on Jonesboro's residents and they are going to take you to task for it – as they should – once they realize truth about what is happening to them.

#### (4) JONESBORO VISION 2030 IS NOT A LOCAL WORK PRODUCT:

We kept hearing city planners say that Jonesboro Vision 2030 is a "local work product" notwithstanding that three ladies, during the January 28, 2013 planning meeting, pointed out several provisions that are verbatim Agenda 21 language; one of the landlords made the statement that provisions within

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Jonesboro Vision 2030 came directly from another city's 'plans' and that those plans mirrored Agenda 21. During the first planning meeting comments were made, and specific Vision 2030 provisions cited, that prove Vision 2030 comes directly out of United Nations' Agenda 21. The statement that Vision 2030 is a "local work product" never had any credibility whatsoever. Irrefutable proof was offered time and time again that Vision 2030 IS United Nations' Agenda 21.

The more I heard about Jonesboro Vision 2030 being a "local work product," the more I came to realize that the only 'local' involvement was to collect and combine Agenda 21 and other foreign regulations into a vague, voluminous and unworkable thing called a 'plan' that is totally foreign to Jonesboro's citizens. The only "work product" represented in Jonesboro's Vision 2030 was a collection of Agenda 21 provisions embodied into a long, vague document that is not a plan at all, but simply a series of statements in support of United Nations' Agenda 21 that even our city planners do not seem to understand.

It is time for Jonesboro's City Council and city personnel to recognize the truth in what they are being told. That truth is very apparent for anyone who spends minimal time reading about U.N. Agenda 21.

#### (5) COMMON SENSE WAYS TO RECOGNIZE AGENDA 21:

There are common sense ways to recognize United Nations' Agenda 21 without regard to the vague and ambiguous language included in documents.

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*Those highlighted in bold, blue italics below are present and highly visible in the Village.* Some of them are:

- "Free money" (grants) with a condition requiring acceptance of Agenda 21 to receive it;
- Additional federal, state or local expenditures that require additional taxation to citizens, whether those taxes are paid to local, state or federal governments all are additional burdens on U.S. citizens and the collective weight of those burdens are what is crushing the U.S. economy and our society;
- Wealth redistribution of any sort, direct or indirect, e.g., 'charitable organizations that will receive and use funds (taxpayer dollars) without the oversight of our Mayor and City Council;
- Population concentrations;
- Involves, or can involve, Imminent Domain Proceedings;
- Long, vague and difficult to understand language;
- Unfamiliar Jargon and undefined terms;
- Difficult to read and understand documents presented late, near approval date designed to prevent understanding of documents to be approved;
- Change of websites where documents are available to the public for review;
- Ambiguous language and unnecessarily complicated business arrangements;
- Attempts to hide or disguise facts and circumstances;
- Actions, events, requirements or expenditures outside traditional American way of life;

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- Benefits to any group that are not clearly defined;
- Overly-complicated corporate structures insulating owners from loss;
- Non-specific "do-gooder" language;
- Any "governmental priority" or governmental department involvement;
- Governmental or MPO control of land use;
- MPO authority control of money (taxpayer dollars) for expenditure, eliminating the authority of local City Councils elected by the people;
- Encourages illegal immigrants to migrate into Jonesboro; they bring with them diseases previously eradicated in the U.S. (e.g., tuberculosis), and wealth redistribution 'requirements' that lower Jonesboro citizen's standards of living;
- Actions and projects that drain local resources and increase the tax burdens of citizens;
- Sounds "too good to be true" and Promises of (certain) success;
- Release of information to the public shortly before decision date(s) (specifically designed to suppress public opposition);
- Unrealistic minimization or ease of operation;
- Vehement and unwavering denial that something is NOT Agenda 21;
- Promises of energy and other efficiencies and aesthetic beauty;
- Bike ways, walk ways, street lane changes or street lane constriction;
- Restrictions on the use of automobiles or actions that make use of automobiles inconvenient and/or uneconomical;
- Traffic control and undefined 'controls' to be imposed upon the public;
- Concentration of contracts to few contractors;

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- Expenditures that do not require competitive bids;
- Expenditures that do not require approval by City Council members;
- Undefined intentions of "control" and control by unelected 'officials;'
- Presentation of "opportunities to comment" that are not widely known and/or biased toward obtaining a desired result to the general public;
- Overt or covert suppression of comments in opposition, to name a few.

#### (6) **OPPOSING COMMENTS ARE NOT INDIVIDUAL CRITICISM**

It would be easy to misconstrue my constructive criticism when there is no intention whatsoever to criticize individuals – especially our Mayor and City Council Members. I intend to criticize no one individually and all of my comments are made with the utmost respect for those to whom I direct them.

I fully realize the complexity of the decision our City Council must make and I hope you have the best of intentions and Jonesboro's best interest in mind as you contemplate the decision before you. You must demonstrate those intentions to Jonesboro's citizens with deeds, not words.

## (7) U.N.'s EXPRESSED INTENTION IS TO IMPLEMENT AGENDA 21 WITHOUT THE KNOWLEDGE & CONSENT OF CITY OFFICIALS

The United Nations has expressed the intention to implement Agenda 21, without the knowledge and consent of local officials all across

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**America**, and all across the world for that matter. My criticism of the unconstitutional provisions of United Nations' Agenda 21, in any form, will continue because I know Agenda 21 is not in the long term interest of the City of Jonesboro or U.S. citizens.

It is no secret that the United Nations seeks total governmental control of the entire world and their environmental objectives are more evil than anything the world we live in has ever known. The United Nations' attempts to gain control of the entire world population are not limited to Agenda 21 only; their sinister attempts span an unbelievably broad spectrum of methods, and from a military point of view their strategies are brilliant. Is there anyone out there naive enough to believe that this was not "the good ole boy system" at work, especially since Harpole's company spent \$150,000 on it before asking approval of the rezoning.

This "village" has been in the planning for two years but hidden from the public; so even when citizens were protesting and planners were denying they were implementing UN Agenda 21, Harpole and other planners were busy at work creating the mixed land use, walkable village that discourages driving and promotes biking and walking (the very essence of Agenda 21) all the time pretending bikeways were for obesity, health, exercise and recreation.

Supporters of the village are now saying they want to live in cramped zero-lot homes so they don't have to mow the grass, but they want to ride their bicycles instead of drive. What a hoot!

# **Unanswered** questions

The Metropolitan Area Planning Commission unanimously approved the request to rezone the land for the "Greensborough Village" so developers could build their UN Agenda 21 walkable, high density, housing project. Several were at the MAPC meeting in opposition, but the MAPC refused to delay the vote even though many opponents' questions went unanswered.

One speaker noted this "village" was classic UN Agenda 21 and that the National Republican Committee passed a resolution opposing Agenda 21 with several state Republican parties (including Arkansas) passing the same resolution. Alabama banned Agenda 21 and its grants from their state with a unanimous vote of both state houses. A leftist liberal also wrote a wellknown book opposing UN Agenda 21.

These resolutions and book describe Agenda 21 as a comprehensive extreme environmental, global political controlled endeavor pushed by policies like "smart growth, green projects and sustainable development," which views the American way of life of private ownership of single family homes, cars and privately owned farms as destructive to the environment.

Another speaker asked what guarantees the city had to prevent an uncompleted development that would leave a mess, naming several places where this happened recently. Her husband asked how existing heavy traffic and added "village" traffic would be resolved. Others asked whether tax money (grants or other) would be utilized in the project, the size of lots, proof there was a need for such a development and projected income levels of prospective home investors and renters.

Jerry Halsey of Halsey, Thrasher, & Harpole answered questions for the developers. On all the above questions he said he had no answer for them. He did reluctantly reveal later to pointed questions they expected 2,200 to 2,500 people to live there, all on 86 acres of the project (29 people an acre); that the size of the houses would range from 1,500 to 5,000 sq. ft. and gave a figure as \$300 a square foot for some of the houses (that would be \$450 thousand for 1,500-square-foot house and \$1.5 million for 5,000-square-foot. But they are advertising it as affordable housing.

Two of my greatest concerns: How much money, grants and tax breaks from city, state and federal government will developers get for complying with Agenda 21? How small will some of the housing units be? When asked, Halsey said he couldn't answer those questions.

Agenda 21 pushes housing units of 200 to 800 square feet to save energy. Will the government subsidize some exclusive housing units in the "village" as they did in Chicago to diversify the neighborhood, another goal of Agenda 21?

Public outcry eventually caused all City Council members to decline the offer of the trip.

The purpose of the trip is to show the officials what they're trying to achieve, the invitation stated.

"Public-Private Partnerships," called "PPPs, 3Ps or P3s," are complex arrangements with beneficial potential, unfortunately replete with fraud and wrongdoing.

Scandals involving 3P cronyism, corporate favoritism, hush money, bribes, kickbacks and unauthorized government guarantees, spending and debt are being discovered all across the U.S. as 3Ps become more widely used and disclosures of impropriety are being reported. Some indictments for 3P fraud are now being prosecuted. 3P structure makes wrongdoing easy to hide; most people don't understand them and unjustifiably rely upon government officials for protection.

3Ps started in the United Kingdom in 1992, the year U.N. Agenda 21 was adopted. 3Ps' political ties run deep, open the door for, and encourage misconduct of government officials and individuals owning (direct or indirect) interests in "preferred partner private investor entities" ("Preferred Partners").

3Ps have been, can be and are being more frequently used by unethical people within government and private entities to:

- a. Secretly implement U.N. Agenda 21 to the detriment of U.S. citizens' personal freedom and/or property rights by:
- b. using tax breaks, regulatory easing and taxpayer subsidies to Preferred Partners (i.e., "corporate welfare"); and unjustly, usually excessively, rewarding Preferred Partners and their owners in return for implementing Agenda 21 projects.

2. Build facilities that cannot prudently be financed by governmental entities, circumventing public approval and hiding (unrecorded and unfunded) government spending and debt.

3. Avoid competitive bidding and encourage "return favors."

4. Guarantee future income to pay off Preferred Partners and make discovery and disclosure of questionable governmental spending and operational practices very difficult.

5. "Lock out" legitimate private investors who don't, and won't, agree to socialistic project components in order to become Preferred Partners.

6. Deny public access to information, because records become Preferred Partners' private property.

7. Circumvent voter approval of taxation, funding and decisions regarding cost and implementation through use of appointed "MPOs," such as Jonesboro's Metropolitan Area Planning Commission (MAPC).

The exceedingly high cost per square foot and failure to disclose even one factor mitigating against implementation of Jonesboro's Greensborough Village ("the Village") in planning documents, standing alone, is enough to raise significant questions about improprieties in the Village.

From the standpoint of the Village's Preferred Partners it's a perfect, risk-free project. Nothing is risk free in private industry unless the risks are shifted to others (e.g., taxpayers). Further, failure to identify Village drawbacks is a strong indication that information has been, and is being, intentionally withheld from Jonesboro's citizens.

Because legitimate private investors typically try to avoid government participation in their operations, it should be obvious that 3Ps were part of the U.N.'s plan to implement Agenda 21. Unfortunately, greed has resulted in adaptation and transformation of 3Ps into ways for unethical government and private industry individuals to use taxpayer dollars to fund personal gain. 3P projects are usually exceedingly high cost with unusually high rates of failure.

Most Jonesboro residents can't afford to pay \$300 per square foot to buy or rent a Village unit, and prudent people won't pay \$300 when they can get the same thing for \$100 or less. Once Preferred Partners receive their target return, often before completion, their corporations become bankrupt, leaving taxpayers with a large debt to pay through increased taxes. Is the Village a "planned failure?"

Gross conflicts of interest in the Village have already been disclosed, tainting the Village and all parties involved. On Aug. 17, a former city employee in charge of much of Jonesboro's Vision 2030 was identified as a partner in the company marketing Village property and recruiting investors for businesses to be located within the Village.

If true, that former employee's actions are a gross conflict of interest using inside information, and possibly city contacts, for personal gain. That individual reportedly denied knowledge of Agenda 21 even though Vision 2030 text was U.N. Agenda 21 word-for-word — marginal credibility at best. Right or wrong, his actions implicate all MAPC members, the city council and all Preferred Partners associated with that individual and the Village. Unanswered questions regarding the Village abound. Jonesboro citizens are obviously rightfully very much concerned about Village improprieties. It doesn't look, sound, feel or smell right. The secretive nature and hurried MAPC Village implementation notwithstanding valid objections manifests impropriety, whether it exists or not.

One of several recommended solutions to prevent 3P fraud and corruption across the U.S. states: "3Ps should not be allowed for funding housing projects or mass transit systems without clear disclosure of costs and taxpayer obligations over 40 years and full vote of approval by citizens."

Jonesboro's MAPC did the opposite, making their rushed decision over valid objections highly suspicious. The Village is filled with 3P earmarks of impropriety.

Jonesboro's citizens cannot determine whether the Village involves impropriety because information city officials and Village Preferred Partners have selectively chosen to provide is

In reply to all the people who asked how Regionalism will affect them living in Jonesboro, we are giving you more information and history on Metro planning. We'll be referring to this Metro network in the future.

Examples of how Regionalism affects us now: Council of State Governments (CSG), American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC), and the National Council of State Legislatures (NCSL). We have referenced these organizations in our previous emails. (Go to SecureArkansas.com and use the Search box.)

Sue Ellen Christian, Tribune Suburban Affairs Writer, wrote this about Chicago on May 8, 1995 – but it could relate to Jonesboro right now. Remember as you read that Metro planners have been attempting to force this idea onto the public for at least a century.

"Imagine a metropolitan Chicago [or Jonesboro... or any metro city over 50,000 people] in which the city and its struggling inner-ring communities got a cut of the tax revenues from new development on the suburban fringes."

"Imagine that all new housing developments in the region had to provide affordable and public housing."

"And imagine that the area's hundreds of political jurisdictions all were subject to statewide regulations aimed at saving open space and redeveloping vacant industrial sites." [Bracketed information ours]

Our elected officials have overcrowded these metropolitan areas, and now we're facing problems of crime-ridden, drug-ridden cities AND suburbs, and they've been doing it incrementally with Section 8 Housing! Look at the problems we're facing: if people do not want to work, then they're subsidized. We are at a point where our American jobs have been exported to foreign countries, like China and Mexico.

Look what we've found so far. Here are some frauds that have occurred in the past with Redevelopment projects across the country:

#### Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) (23 CFR 450.310)

An Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is an agency created by <u>federal law (23 CFR 450.310)</u> to provide local input for urban transportation planning and allocating federal transportation funds to cities with populations of greater than 50,000. MPOs are responsible for approving significant expenditures of federal dollars.

#### Taxation without representation

There are plenty of concerns with how MPOs are governed. Only elected officials should have voting powers on MPOs. Since MPOs have the power to allocate billions in tax money, to allow

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unelected bureaucrats voting powers is equivalent to taxation without representation. The Jonesboro MPO lacks representation of taxpayers' interests in this way with many of its members being unelected bureaucrats. Though the federal law creating MPOs allows ArDOT and transit officials to be a part of MPOs, it should be limited to an advisory capacity only.

Not only is there a conflict of interest in voting for its own projects and to vote itself more money, it already possesses the power to approve all projects through the Arkansas Transportation Commission, which already results in most MPOs deferring to ArDOT in formulating and voting on MPO plans. For all the talk of "local control," ARDOT steers and often controls MPOs, not the local officials who sit on these local transportation planning boards.

#### Jonesboro Metropolitan Planning Organization - Public Participation Plan

Public participation is required by the prevailing federal legislation. The federal legislation requiring public participation is the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) (Pub. L. 109-59, 119 Stat. 1144; as amended) The other requirements of public participation is covered in the Jonesboro MPO – Public Participation Plan.

Don't be fooled by the public participation. The method that is being used is <u>the Delphi Technique</u>. The Delphi Technique is very effective with parents, teachers, school children, and community groups. The "targets" rarely, if ever, realize that they are being manipulated. If they do suspect what is happening, they do not know how to end the process. The facilitator seeks to polarize the group in order to become an accepted member of the group and of the process. The desired idea is then placed on the table, and individual opinions are sought during discussion. Soon, associates from the divided group begin to adopt the idea as if it were their own, and they pressure the entire group to accept their proposition. The Delphi method is being used at all levels of government to move meetings to present conclusions. Never let the Delphi facilitator to split the committee or group into small groups. The whole group needs to hear everything being said at the meeting.

Current Councilman, Rennell Woods, is the owner or owns an interest in Whole Youth Services, Inc. and Kingdom Management, LLC d/b/a Next Level Training located at 3916 Brandywine, Jonesboro, Arkansas 72404,

Section 1: The City Council for the City of Jonesboro gives special permission for Rennell Woods owner of Whole Youth Services, Inc. and Kingdom Management, LLC d/b/a Next Level Training to be allowed to provide services for the City of Jonesboro.

At present no alderman, council member, official, or municipal employee shall be interested, directly or indirectly, in the profits of any contract for furnishing supplies, equipment, or services to the municipality. For the City of Jonesboro to get around the Conflict of Interest Law, an ordinance must be passed to make it legal to have a conflict of interest. Ordinance 14-048 is based on <u>Arkansas</u> Code 14-42-107 (b)(1)

(b) (1) No alderman, council member, official, or municipal employee shall be interested, directly or indirectly, in the profits of any contract for furnishing supplies, equipment, or services to the municipality unless the governing body of the city has enacted an ordinance specifically permitting aldermen, council members, officials, or municipal employees to conduct business with the city and prescribing the extent of this authority.

(2) Nor shall a commissioner or employee have any direct or indirect interest in any contract or proposed contract for materials or services to be furnished for use in connection with any project.

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(b) (1) If any commissioner or employee of an authority owns or controls a direct or indirect interest in property included, or planned to be included, in any project, he immediately shall disclose it in writing to the authority. This disclosure shall be entered upon the minutes of the authority.

(2) Failure to disclose his interest shall constitute misconduct in office.

For those of you not familiar with the Jonesboro Metropolitan Planning Commission, here are their <u>2014 Bylaws and Operating Procedures</u>.

From their document:

"The name of this committee shall be the Transportation Policy Committee for the Jonesboro Metropolitan Planning Organization.

Composition:

The present voting membership of this Committee is as follows.

Voting Members:

1. Three Members from the City of Jonesboro, to include the Mayor and two other members appointed by the Mayor.

2. Two Members from the County of Craighead, to include the Judge of the Craighead County Quorum Court and one other member appointed by the Judge.

3. The Mayor of the City of Brookland or a member appointed by him/her.

4. The Mayor of the City of Bono or a member appointed by him/her.

5. The Mayor of the City of Bay or a member appointed by him/her.

6. Two Members from the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department.

7. One member from the Jonesboro Economical Transportation System (JETS) Advisory Board. Alternate Members:

Each voting member may appoint an alternate member, by a written and formal designation, who may serve at any Transportation Policy Committee meeting in the voting member's absence. An Appointed alternate member will have the voting rights and privileges of the member when serving in the absence of the voting member."

It appears to us that these Alternates could do whatever they want! Please read the **Amendment Notes** on the last page. This is a good example of abuse by unelected officials.

If your community has a "Vision" Plan, a "Master" Plan, or a "Comprehensive" Plan, you can bet it's Sustainable Development – which is U.N. Agenda 21.
