My name is Cassidy Lucas and I am the owner of 4214 Cornerstone Drive. I am seeking a variance permit to build a fence in my side yard.

My partner and I moved into our new house in early June 2021 with our two dogs. Shortly after, we began the process of getting a fence built in our yard. After some internet research, I selected a fence builder that had many high ratings. I was new to the process and asked the fence builder if they would handle the permits or if I needed to apply for them. My builder told me that I didn't need to do anything and that he would handle all of the permit paperwork.

On June 24th, our fence was installed. I was under the impression that everything was settled until I received a citation from the city of Jonesboro about our new fence. I contacted the Planning office to inquire about the citation and sure enough, my contractor failed to apply for the permit he said he was going to apply for. I was also advised to fill out a variance application. My contractor apologized and said that he would take care of all the variance paperwork and fees. He told me applied for it on July 21st.

Several weeks went by, and I hadn't heard anything from the city about my variance application. I was checking the city meeting agendas regularly to see when I needed to attend a meeting.
