RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS, EXTENDING A MORATORIUM FOR APPLICATION FOR, CONSIDERATION OF OR APPROVAL OF R-2A OR R-3 REZONING CLASSIFICATION REQUESTS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Jonesboro has determined that a need exists to extend the time for review, consideration and adoption of amendments to the city's zoning ordinance to provide for the separate single-family and multi-family zoning classifications.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS THAT:

- 1. A moratorium is hereby declared on the application for, consideration of or approval of R-2A or R-3 rezoning classification requests for a period of 45 days beginning on the date this resolution is passed.
- 2. During this moratorium period, an ordinance or ordinances providing for separate single-family and multi-family zoning classifications without creating a taking of property rights by the city regarding property currently zoned R-2A or R-3 are to be prepared by city staff, reviewed by the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission and adopted by the City Council.
- 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
