AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE JONESBORO FIRE DEPARTMENT PROPOSED PAY REALIGNMENT PLAN

WHEREAS; The City of Jonesboro has seven (7) Captains and seventeen (17) Drivers making less money than Officers and Firefighters of lower ranks.

WHEREAS; The City of Jonesboro Fire Department wishes to upgrade the twenty-four (24) members pay through step increases to the lowest step above the highest pay of the rank immediately below.

WHEREAS; The City of Jonesboro Fire Department wishes to give the employees listed in exhibit A step increases from their current pay to their new pay step with an additional total cost of \$75,248.11 to payroll for the remainder of 2008 budget year.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1: The City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, hereby adopts the Jonesboro Fire Department Pay Realignment Plan (exhibit A).

Section 2: The 2008 annual budget for the City of Jonesboro, Adopted as Ordinance 08-008 on Jan 24, 2008 is amended by an additional \$75,248.11 to convert the 24 Fire Officers (Captains and Drivers) from their current Grade and Step to their new Grade and Step (see exhibit B).

Section 3: The City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, establishes the base pay for each rank within the Jonesboro Fire Department as shown the realignment Plan in accordance with Grade and Step.
