AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 2237 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS, TO DELETE THE ORDINANCE IN ITS ENTIRETY; THEREBY PLACING THE DEPARTMENT OF CODE ENFORCEMENT UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR AS ORIGINALLY STATED IN ORDINANCE NO. 2229.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 2237 is hereby deleted in its entirety from the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 2: It is further found and declared by the City Council that an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall take effect from and after its approval.
