United States Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Services (NRCS) entered into a contract with the City for services to relieve hazards represented by flooding in April/May of 2011 at designated site 1, Higginbottom Creek and was signed on July 3, 2012. The estimated cost for this project is \$425,620.30, with 75% of the cost being paid by NRCS and the other 25% being paid by the City of Jonesboro. The resolution number is RES-12:106 and was approved by Council on July 2, 2012.
