AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES  
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas:

Section 1: The City Council finds and declares that the conditions of traffic are such as to endanger the traveling public and pedestrians on certain streets and at certain inter-sections and that certain traffic control devices are to be established and placed on the following streets and locations:

- (a) One way designation on Houston Street from Logan Street to East Matthews Street. Traffic will flow from north to south on Houston Street. This designation will be in effect from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on school days only.
- (b) The school bus loading and unloading zone on the west side of Houston Street from Logan Street to East Matthews Street. This designation will be in effect from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on school days only.
- (c) Loading and unloading zone designation on south side of Logan Street from Borgman Street to Houston Street. This zone shall be used solely for parents to discharge and load children. It will be in effect from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on school days only.
- (d) No parking designation on the east side of Anne Street from Owens Street to Sims Street.

Section 2: The drivers of all vehicles shall obey all traffic control signs per instruction on the face thereof.

Section 3: The Chief of Police or some person designated by him is hereby directed to place and locate upon the above described street at the proper places, appropriate signs designating traffic control as set out above and it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to tear down, remove or mutilate said signs.

Section 4: Every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00.

Section 5: All ordinances and/or part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6: It is found and declared by the City Council that due to increasing traffic congestion and lack of traffic control devices on these streets, there is a great possibility that failure to have these control devices will cause danger to life and property, therefore:

An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
