A RESOLUTION TO THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS TO ACCEPT THE LOW BID AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CRAWFORD BUILDERS, INC. FOR THE RANCHETTE ACRES - SEWER CONNECTIONS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Jonesboro has desires to accept the low bid and enter into a contract for the Ranchette Acres - Sewer Connections Project;

WHEREAS, the low bidder and the firm selected for the Ranchette Acres - Sewer Connections Project is Crawford Builders, Inc.;

WHEREAS, funding for the execution of the contract shall be 100% funded by HUD, Department of Housing and Urban Development, and compensation shall be paid in accordance with the contract documents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1: That the City of Jonesboro shall accept the low bid and enter into a contract with for the Ranchette Acres - Sewer Connections Project with Crawford Builders, Inc.

Section 2: That funding for the execution of the contract shall be 100% funded by HUD, Department of Housing and Urban Development, and compensation shall be paid in accordance with the contract documents.

Section 3: The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized by the City Council for the City of Jonesboro to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this agreement.
