WHEREAS, the Parks Department for the City of Jonesboro needs remove the permanent mounds and replace the area with Artificial Turf Surfacing.

WHEREAS, GeoSurfaces will remove and dispose of concrete pitching mounds on 10 fields. Level existing concrete under previous footprint of mound. Install Geoflo pad and seam to existing pad. Install clay colored GeoGreen Turf Radius in place of old mound. Install sports field sand and rubber.

WHEREAS, the cost of this project is \$43,022.00.

WHEREAS, the City Council in accord with the terms of A.C.A. Section 14-58-303 states that bidding in this matter is not practical and hereby waives the requirement of competitive bidding due to the fact that GeoSurfaces Artificial Turf is the compatible match to the existing Artificial Turf. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this agreement.
