AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1204, SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE BUILDING CODE FOR THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas:

Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1204 is amended as follows:

There is hereby adopted by the City Council of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the construction, operation, removal, demolition of equipment used in occupancy, location, maintenance of building structures, including permits and penalties that contain building code known as the Standard Building Code, being particularly the 1976 edition thereto, of which not less than three (3) copies have been and now are filed in our office of the City Inspector of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, the same are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein and from the date of which this article shall take effect, provisions thereof shall be controlling in the construction of all buildings and structures herein contained within the corporate limits of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas.

Section 2: All Ordinances and/or parts of Ordinances conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: It is found and declared by the City Council that his Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.
