Name of street: Primrose Street & Stallings Lane

Description of property to be abandoned: An alley running North and South; the same being 10 feet wide connecting Primrose Street & Stallings Lane and more particularly described as beginning at a point 15 feet East of the NW corner of the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 14 North, Range 4 East; thence run East 200 feet for the point of beginning; thence run South 650 feet; thence East 10 feet; thence North 650 feet; thence West 10 feet to the point of beginning proper.
