A RESOLUTION TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO TO CONDEMN CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF JONESBORO AT 1415 CURTIS ROAD FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING A DETENTION POND.

WHEREAS, the City of Jonesboro has the need to condemn by eminent domain certain property located within the City of Jonesboro located at <u>1415 Curtis Road</u>, Jonesboro, Arkansas for the purpose of creating a detention pond; And

WHEREAS, an offer of \$14,000.00 has been made and refused by <u>Aaron Harris</u> dated March 18, 2008 refusing to sell their property located at 1415 Curtis Road, Jonesboro, Arkansas more particularly described as follows:

A part of the SE 1/4, SW 1/4, Section 36, Township 14 North, Range 3 East; also known as 1415 Curtis Road

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council for the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas that:

SECTION 1: That the City of Jonesboro is hereby vested with the power of eminent domain and authorized under Arkansas Code Annotated 18-15-309 to condemn said property located at <u>1415 Curtis Road</u>, Jonesboro, Arkansas.

SECTION 2: This condemnation is necessary to obtain property for construction of detention ponds in the City of Jonesboro.

SECTION 3: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
