AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE AND ABANDON A 5' PORTION OF AN EXISTING 10' DRAINAGE & UTILITY EASEMENT. SAID PORTION BEING THE SOUTH 5' OF THE NORTH 10' OF LOT 58 OF TOWER PARK ESTATES, PHASE FIVE TO THE CITY OF JONESBORO, CRAIGHEAD COUNTY, ARKANSAS, LYING EAST OF AN EXISTING 10' DRAINAGE & UTILITY EASEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, that:

SECTION ONE: The City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, hereby releases, vacates and abandons all of its rights, together with the rights of the public generally, in and to the portion of this Easement designated as follows:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

THE SOUTH 5' OF THE NORTH 10' OF LOT 58 OF TOWER PARK ESTATES, PHASE FIVE TO THE CITY OF JONESBORO, CRAIGHEAD COUNTY, ARKANSAS, LYING EAST OF AN EXISTING 10' DRAINAGE & UTILITY EASEMENT.

SECTION TWO: A copy of the ordinance duly certified by the City Clerk shall be filed in the office of the Recorder of Craighead County, Arkansas and shall be filed in the Deed Records of such office.

SECTION THREE: It is further found due to the immediate need to acquire this property, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.
