A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM ENHANCEMENT FUNDS WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas understands Federal-Aid Surface Transportation Enhancement Funds are available at 50 % Federal participation and 50 % local cash match for the following project: signalization at the intersection of State Highway 18 (Highland Drive) and Bittle Street / Fairpark Boulevard
