### RESOLUTION TO LEVY A 1 MILL TAX ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY FOR THE PUBLIC LIBRARY TAX

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the terms of Amendment No.30 to the State of Arkansas Constitution, authorizing the qualified electors of cities having a population of not less than 3000 to vote and levy a public library tax, a petition signed by more than 100 tax-paying electors of the City of Jonesboro was filed with the Mayor Hubert Bosler asking that an annual tax on all real and personal property within the City, specifying a rate of taxation of 1 mill on the dollar.

WHEREUPON, said Mayor certified to the Board of Election Commissioners of Craighead County that said petition was filed with him, March 1, 1941, 30 days prior to the General Election as required by law and that said petition was signed by more than 100 taxpayers.

WHEREAS, said Board of Election Commissioners placed the question on the ballot. A majority of the qualified voters voted for the levy and the Mayor proclaimed it adopted as law.

PASSED and ADOPTED this 15<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1982.
